Mr. Evers:

This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated 21 February 2020 and received by the Information Management Division on 24 February 2020, in which you requested 6 items that pertain to the listed named individuals:

- "1. The resume provided by the individual to the agency in connection with determining the appropriate salary or salaries for the individual, or, if that is not available, a recent resume contained within the agency's records. We have no objection to the redaction of contact information (addresses, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses) for the employee or references, or to the redaction of past salary information. Employment, education, and professional association information is not exempt and we object to any redactions of such information.*
- 2. Any conflicts or ethics waivers or authorizations for the individual, including authorizations pursuant to 5 C.F.R. § 2635.502.*
- 3. Records reflecting any recusal determination made or issued for the individual.*
- 4. Any other ethics guidance or directives issued to the individual.*
- 5. Copies of any SF-50 forms for the individual reflecting any change in position or title, including when the employee enters or leaves a position. We have no objection to the redaction of home addresses, telephone numbers, or social security numbers from the SF-50s.*
- 6. Copies of signed and dated signature form pages reflecting the individual's certification of statements made in the Questionnaire for National Security Positions (SF-86)."*

A search has been conducted and no records responsive to your request were located. However, please note that had records been located, ODNI would not have been able to provide them without signed authorization from the individuals concerned.

The request letter and envelope or subject line of the email should be marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." Your appeal must be postmarked or electronically transmitted within 90 days of the date of this letter.
