On March 23, 2020, pursuant to USDA regulation 7 C.F.R. § 1.4(c), the FOIA Division routed parts of your request, specifically Items vii, ix, x, xi, xvi, and xvii in Column A, to REE for processing and direct response to you.

By letter dated August 19, 2020, REE issued an interim response which included twenty (20) pages of responsive records. Subsequently, REE continued processing the manual portion of your FOIA request.

Your request has been processed under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552.

A manual search for responsive records was conducted. The search did not locate any additional records that are responsive to your FOIA request. As a result, REE is not able to provide any responsive records.

You may appeal this response by email at USDAFOIA@usda.gov. Your appeal must be in writing, and it must be received electronically no later than 90 calendar days from the date of this letter. The OGC will not consider appeals received after the 90 calendar-day limit. Appeals

The appeal letter should include the FOIA tracking number listed above, a copy of the original request, the FOIA Division's response to your original request, and a statement explaining the basis of your appeal. For quickest possible handling, the subject line of your email should be marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." You should also reference FOIA No. 2020-REE-03160-F.
