Dear Ms. Sloan:

This is the initial agency decision on your March 6, 2020 request, under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, to the Department of State (DOS) for documents pertaining to the burglary of storage units belonging to former Secretary of State, Mike Pompeo.

DS was forwarded your FOIA request on July 13, 2020. Your FOIA request was assigned the tracking number at the top of this letter. Please include the tracking number in all future communications concerning this FOIA request.

Please be advised that a search has been conducted in DS and 42 pages were located that are responsive to your request.

After carefully reviewing the records responsive to your request, I have determined that eight pages are being released to you in their entirety and 34 pages are released in part pursuant to:

- 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which concerns material the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual's personal privacy.
- 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C), which concerns records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of an individual's personal privacy.
- 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(E), which concerns records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes the release of which would divulge techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions.

The overwhelming majority of illegal drugs in the United States already come from Mexico and Mexican traffickers are the greatest criminal threat to the nation, but things are about to get worse when Mexico's new leftwing president takes over. His name is Andrés Manuel López Obrador (known popularly as AMLO), he opposes hardline anti-drug policies and believes in

amnesty for drug war criminals. A State Department document obtained by Judicial Watch warns that Obrador, who takes over on December 1, will seek to decriminalize marijuana and poppy cultivation early in his term.

Pompeo meeting postponed, but Trump still hopes to meet with Kim next year

Reuters reports that at his press conference Wednesday, President Trump said he "expects to meet with North Korea's leader Kim Jong Un some time early next year and that an expected meeting between" Secretary of State Pompeo and North Korean officials "will be rescheduled." + Washington Post; Washington Times; New York Times

Russia wants UN meeting on easing North Korean sanctions

Fox News' Special Report reported that Russia has requested that the UN Security Council discuss possible easing of sanctions against North Korea during a Security Council session tomorrow. Moscow's request "comes as Secretary of State Mike Pompeo postpones a meeting with North Korea officials in New York."

Vietnam, US complete toxic cleanup at Danang airport

AP reports that Vietnam and the US "finished the cleanup of dioxin contamination at Danang airport caused by the transport and storage of the herbicide Agent Orange during the Vietnam War." Large quantities of Agent Orange "were stored at Danang airport during the war and sprayed by US forces to defoliate the countryside and deny communist fighters jungle cover." US Ambassador Daniel Kritenbrink said, "This project truly is a hallmark of our countries' shared vision to be honest about the past, deal responsibly with remaining legacy issues and turn a point of contention into one of collaboration."

Taiwan's president inaugurates two frigates from US

AFP reports on Thursday, Taiwanese President Tsai Ing-wen spoke at the inauguration of "two frigates bought from the United States aimed at boosting Taipei's naval capabilities against China." Tsai said, "We want to send a clear and firm message from Taiwanese people to the international community that we will not concede one step in defending Taiwan and protecting our free and democratic way of life."

MIDDLE EAST

US warns against allowing Iranian tankers into ports

AP reports the US "is warning foreign countries not to allow Iranian oil tankers into their territorial waters or ports." According to the State Department, allowing their presence "may run afoul of U.S. sanctions." The department added that "insuring Iranian tankers is also a violation of the U.S. sanctions that came into force this week."

High court considers case related to USS Cole bombing

AP reports that Supreme Court on Wednesday considered "whether to overturn a nearly \$315 million judgment against Sudan stemming from the bombing of the USS Cole." The Court is being asked to decide "where notice of the lawsuit against Sudan should have been mailed, to its embassy in Washington or its foreign ministry in the country's capital, Khartoum." + [Washington Post](#)

US envoy to Syria says US is focused on pressuring Iran to withdraw

AP reports Ambassador James Jeffrey, US envoy to Syria, said Wednesday that the US "will focus on pressuring Iran financially and contesting its activities in Syria, Iraq and Yemen." He said that with respect to Syria, "Iranians are part of the problem not part of the solution."

Kidnapped Students In Cameroon Have Been Released

The [New York Times](#) (11/7, Searcey, 17.59M) reports, "Dozens of students kidnapped from a boarding school in a restive region of Cameroon were freed late Tuesday," it was announced on Wednesday. The [AP](#) (11/7, Moki) reports the announcement was made by "Fonki Samuel Forba, moderator of the country's Presbyterian Church."

CENTRAL AMERICA

Members Of migrant caravan consider offers to remain in Mexico

AP reports about 4,500 Central American migrants taking a rest stop at a Mexico City stadium "continue to weigh offers to stay in Mexico against the desire of many to reach the U.S. border." The migrants "declined to take an immediate decision Tuesday night on whether to stay in Mexico or continue north, opting to remain in the capital at least a couple more days."

California man sentenced for shooting US Vice Consul in Guadalajara

AP reports Zia Zafar, 33, of Chino Hills, California, was sentenced to more than 20 years in prison for shooting Vice Consul Christopher Ashcraft in 2017 in Guadalajara, Mexico. The AP adds, "Ashcraft survived, but the bullet remains lodged in his spinal column."

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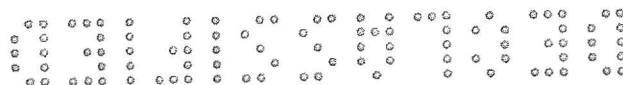
