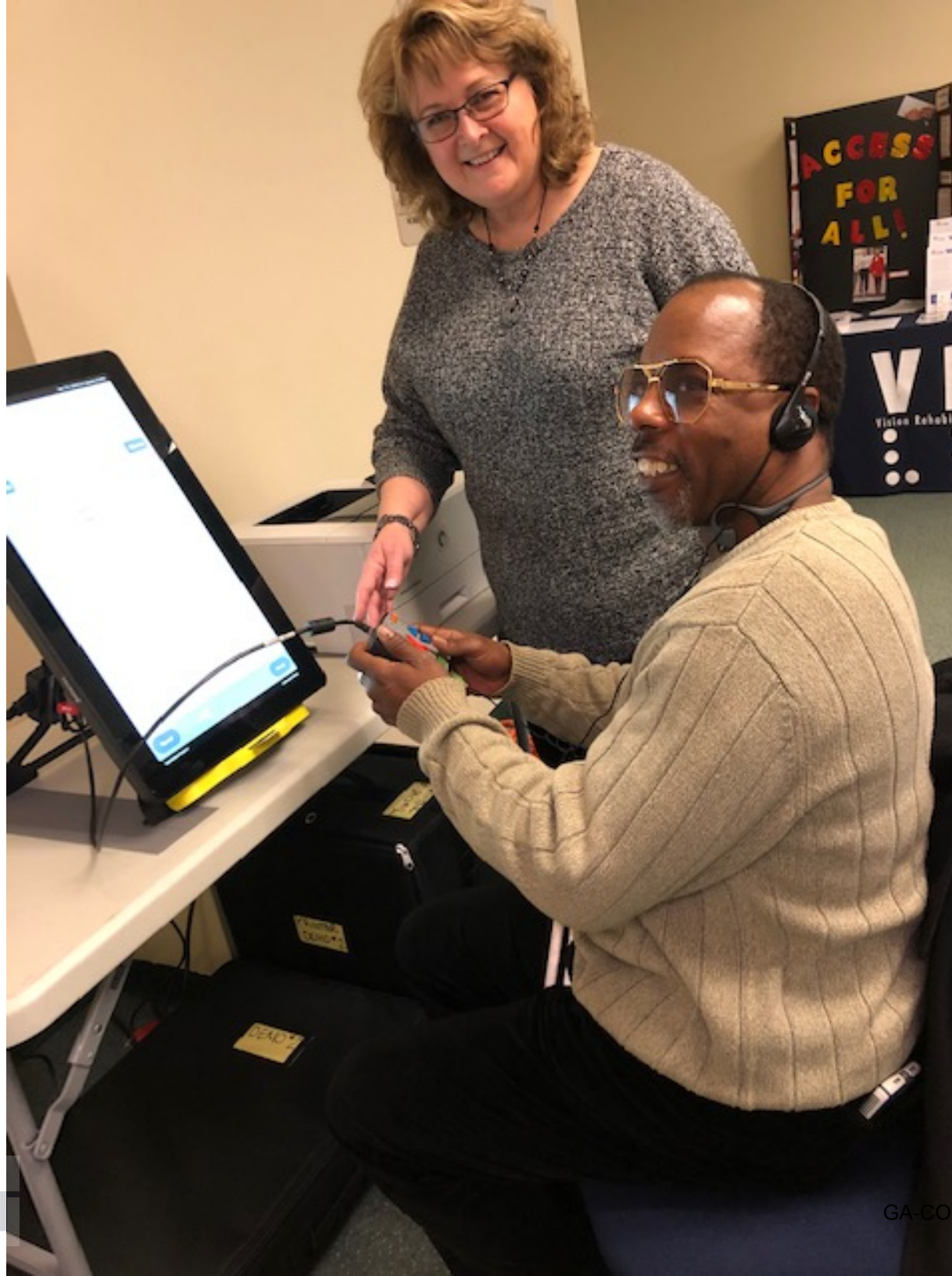

On Saturday February 29, Election Director Janine Eveler and several members of her staff had the pleasure of demonstrating voting equipment accessibility to clients of Vision Rehabilitation Services of Georgia, in Smyrna. When requested, poll workers will encode a voter access card to activate the audio tactile interface on the Touchscreen. The voter can then use the headphones to hear the instructions and the audio ballot. The system can be configured to work with several types of assistive devices for making ballot selections. George Vickers, president of Cobb County's chapter of the National Federation of the Blind uses the provided ATI device to make his selections on the demonstration ballot. The State Election Board has recently passed a rule allowing vision-impaired voters to use their own text-reader devices or apps to help them verify their printed ballot before placing it in the scanner.

Chris,

Yesterday, my team and I had the pleasure of demonstrating the voting system to clients at Vision Rehabilitation Services of Georgia, [3830 South Cobb Drive, Ste 125, Smyrna](#). I believe we learned more from them than they did from us, and I wanted to pass on some of the concerns that were expressed.

1. While listening to the audio version of the demonstration ballot, it was discovered that the voice would not read the party affiliation after speaking the candidate name. This may be a setting in the election project that we can fix. I assume it also would not speak the word "incumbent" either, although that is not in the demo ballot. This will be important in May and November, so we wanted to point it out now.
2. There was concern about the functionality of the ATI device and the way the buttons worked. Often the blue up/down arrows and yellow left/right arrows navigate to the same destination and other times they do not. To a blind person, it was not easy to tell where each would go. For instance, once you are in the information bar at the top, you cannot use the blue down arrow to get out of it and go down to the ballot. The blue down arrow will simply move you right to the next option in the information bar.
3. When they did want to go to the information bar, they could not figure out how to get there until one voter discovered that the red X would take you there as long as you were not on a list of selections, such as when you are in the race heading. The voters asked if there would be a guide available showing how to navigate the ballot, and we said we didn't think so at this time. The green Help bar brings up a description of the ATI device and describes the shapes and colors of the buttons and what they do. However, the buttons did not always seem to do the action they were intended to do. One voter made the comment that describing the color of the button was useless to him.
4. Similar to number 3, the write-in keyboard was very hard to use with the ATI device. Both yellow and blue arrows only went left and right along the keyboard, there wasn't a way to go down to the next row of letters. Navigating from A to Z and back again to spell a name was very difficult and you could not hold down the button and advance multiple letters, you have to push the button down for each letter. The voters suggested that the touchscreen tablet should be set up like their phones, so that they could touch the screen and it will read the letters or words. These are accessibility settings available on phones and iPads. Then when the right selection is read, they either remove their finger or they double-tap to select that letter. Another suggestion was to attach a key board.
5. There was concern that each poll would only be provided with one ATI device; considering how long it took to use the device. The comment was made that they must not have asked a blind person when they designed this.
6. We also had a voter who was both deaf and blind and we had to tell him that we didn't think there was anything in the system that would allow him to vote independently. He has a braille device that connects via Bluetooth or USB to read things, but we told him we could not accommodate that device.
7. Regarding the Poll Pad, there was a concern about the unit speaking the voter's name and address out loud. First, the pronunciation was rudimentary, for instance pronouncing Elm Rd. as "Elm R D". An iPad can be given pronunciation hints to help with these common terms. Second, they wanted to listen with headphones attached to the Poll Pad, so others would not hear their information. Thirdly, they really preferred that the iPad's accessibility functions be turned on so they could touch the screen and it would read the selection (as described above). We tried doing this ourselves later and found that it does work except that when the voter chooses a ballot style, the Poll Pad does not advance to create the card. We're guessing the Poll Pad application is not written to use these features.
8. Regarding the Scanner, they really liked that you can hear the ballot drop into the box. However, they wanted something tactile on the arrows indicating where to insert the ballot. They suggested a sticker with raised dots or even a hot glue gun dot so they could feel something.

The clients had a lot of ideas and suggestions and it was very enlightening. The Director of the Center, Kay Eller, said she would be willing to assist anyone looking into making system improvements for disabled voters going forward. In the

short-term, having a written guide for poll workers or enhancing the audio help guide to describe how to navigate the ballot would be a big help for poll workers and voters using the ATI.

Subject: Voters with Disabilities

Chris,

Yesterday, my team and I had the pleasure of demonstrating the voting system to clients at Vision Rehabilitation Services of Georgia, 3830 South Cobb Drive, Ste 125, Smyrna. I believe we learned more from them than they did from us, and I wanted to pass on some of the concerns that were expressed.

1. While listening to the audio version of the demonstration ballot, it was discovered that the voice would not read the party affiliation after speaking the candidate name. This may be a setting in the election project that we can fix. I assume it also would not speak the word "incumbent" either, although that is not in the demo ballot. This will be important in May and November, so we wanted to point it out now.
2. There was concern about the functionality of the ATI device and the way the buttons worked. Often the blue up/down arrows and yellow left/right arrows navigate to the same destination and other times they do not. To a blind person, it was not easy to tell where each would go. For instance, once you are in the information bar at the top, you cannot use the blue down arrow to get out of it and go down to the ballot. The blue down arrow will simply move you right to the next option in the information bar.
3. When they did want to go to the information bar, they could not figure out how to get there until one voter discovered that the red X would take you there as long as you were not on a list of selections, such as when you are in the race heading. The voters asked if there would be a guide available showing how to navigate the ballot, and we said we didn't think so at this time. The green Help bar brings up a description of the ATI device and describes the shapes and colors of the buttons and what they do. However, the buttons did not always seem to do the action they were intended to do. One voter made the comment that describing the color of the button was useless to him.
4. Similar to number 3, the write-in keyboard was very hard to use with the ATI device. Both yellow and blue arrows only went left and right along the keyboard, there wasn't a way to go down to the next row of letters. Navigating from A to Z and back again to spell a name was very difficult and you could not hold down the button and advance multiple letters, you have to push the button down for each letter. The voters suggested that the touchscreen tablet should be set up like their phones, so that they could touch the screen and it will read the letters or words. These are accessibility settings available on phones and iPads. Then when the right selection is read, they either remove their finger or they double-tap to select that letter. Another suggestion was to attach a key board.
5. There was concern that each poll would only be provided with one ATI device; considering how long it took to use the device. The comment was made that they must not have asked a blind person when they designed this.
6. We also had a voter who was both deaf and blind and we had to tell him that we didn't think there was anything in the system that would allow him to vote independently. He has a braille device that connects via Bluetooth or USB to read things, but we told him we could not accommodate that device.
7. Regarding the Poll Pad, there was a concern about the unit speaking the voter's name and address out loud. First, the pronunciation was rudimentary, for instance pronouncing Elm Rd. as "Elm R D". An iPad can be given pronunciation hints to help with these common terms. Second, they wanted to listen with headphones attached to the Poll Pad, so others would not hear their information. Thirdly, they really preferred that the iPad's accessibility functions be turned on so they could touch the screen and it would read the selection (as described above). We tried doing this ourselves later and found that it does work except that when the voter chooses a ballot style, the Poll Pad does not advance to create the card. We're guessing the Poll Pad application is not written to use these features.
8. Regarding the Scanner, they really liked that you can hear the ballot drop into the box. However, they wanted something tactile on the arrows indicating where to insert the ballot. They suggested a sticker with raised dots or even a hot glue gun dot so they could feel something.

The clients had a lot of ideas and suggestions and it was very enlightening. The Director of the Center, Kay Eller, said she would be willing to assist anyone looking into making system improvements for disabled voters going forward. In the short-term, having a written guide for poll workers or enhancing the audio help guide to describe how to navigate the ballot would be a big help for poll workers and voters using the ATI.
