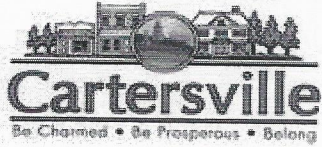

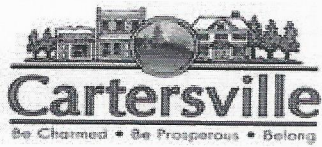

BARTOW COUNTY ELECTION BOARD MEETING
February 10, 2020 – 3:00 p.m.

Shep Helton, Bartow County Board of Education

Ms. Janet Queen called the meeting to order at 3:00pm.

As the first order of business, Mr. Dexter Benning made a motion to accept the previous meeting's minutes with a second from Mr. Ken Cathcart. The motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor's Report

Budget: Mr. Joseph Kirk informed the board that he is still waiting on the final budget for 2019 and the current monthly budget, but will be available at the next meeting.

Voting system: The bulk of the new system has been delivered and the office is just waiting on a few non-essential accessories. Naomi, the new technician from Dominion, has started working and has done well. Brad, the previous technician from the pilot, was promoted to regional manager.

Election preparation: Ballots are in and are already being mailed out, with over 50 out on time for legal deadlines. Logic and accuracy testing will begin on the 17th at the new warehouse on Branton Rd. It will be scheduled for half-days starting out and contacting the office for daily availability is recommended. The first training class for the presidential primary happened earlier in the day and went well. Mr. Kirk recommended that the board come to a class to see the new system and introduce themselves to poll workers. A student poll worker program is being launched for this election through the Bartow County College and Career Academy. Ms. Queen recommended bringing Cartersville High School in as well.

Voting machine demonstrations: Mr. Benning explained that he is reaching out to churches and community organizations to offer demonstrations and asks that other board members give him recommendations for more. He and Mr. Powell discussed demonstrating to a veteran's group. The next big demonstration will be on February 18th at the courthouse in partnership with the Secretary of State's office and at Cartersville City Hall on February 28th in partnership with the city.

After listening to the report Mr. Cathcart made a motion to accept it as presented, which was seconded by Mr. Benning.

There were no open issues to discuss.

New Business

Call for Special Election: Mr. Kirk presented the board with a resolution to call an educational SPLOST and informed the board that all legal advertising has already been taken care of. Shep Helton, attorney for the Bartow County Board of Education, explained it is a joint resolution with the City of Cartersville's school system to continue the current eSplost and get permission to issue bonds. A motion was put forth by Mr. Benning to sign the resolution, seconded by Mr. Cathcart and the vote passed unanimously.

There was no comment from the public.

At 3:12pm, Mr. Benning motioned to adjourn and Mr. Cathcart seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

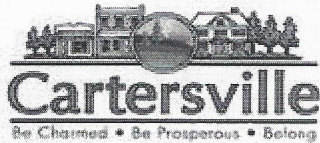
