This letter is a second interim response to your request for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, dated March 30, 2020 and received in this office on March 31, 2020. Your request was forwarded to the appropriate office to search for documents that may be responsive to your request.

You requested the following:

The outbreak of the novel coronavirus, SARS-CoV-2, and the disease it causes, COVID-19, has been declared a public health emergency at both the national and international levels.¹ On March 2, 2020, the Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions sent a letter to Secretary DeVos requesting information regarding how Education is preparing for the effect the spread of the virus will have on education stakeholders. ² American Oversight seeks records to shed light on Education's response to the coronavirus outbreak.
