Good Evening Agency GCs –

Thank you for your hard work the past weeks in rapidly preparing and responding to COVID-19. As you all know, we are now in a statewide State of Emergency. DEM Director Jared Moskowitz is the State Coordinating Officer and is leading logistics and operational response. Dr. Scott Rivkees, our Surgeon General and State Health Officer, is a Deputy State Coordinating Officer and State Incident Commander. Dr. Rivkees is directing the response for the public health emergency.

The provisions of the EO mirror those in a traditional EO for a hurricane or other natural disaster, particularly Section 4(B) which gives State Agencies the ability to suspend a regulatory statute, order, ordinance or rule. This can only be done if (1) prescribed by the CEMP or (2) ordered by the State Coordinating Officer. Therefore, as we do with hurricanes and other natural disasters, we are going to utilize a structured chain of command for any legal action your agency may wish to take. **If your agency needs to waive a statute, order, ordinance or rule, please e-mail the following people in that request: your Deputy GC in our office, Joe Jacquot, and myself.** Since the EO requires the SCO

order the waiver (with authorization by the Governor), either Joe or I will approve, modify or deny the request and make sure you receive written confirmation.

If you have any initial or preliminary questions, please discuss with your Deputy General Counsel and make sure they are fully briefed on the issue before sending a request. Everyone did a phenomenal job during Hurricane Dorian, and I have no doubts that we will continue to have a great response to this emergency. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to reach out.

Dear Mr. President,

I am writing to request authority and funding under 502(f)(2)(A) of Title 32, U.S. Code. Under this title, you and the Secretary of Defense may authorize the use of already appropriated federal training funds for the Florida National Guard to respond to incidents requiring resources essential for the preservation of life and property. With this status, and proper resourcing, the Florida National Guard can best support our State, the Department of Health and Human Resources and the Department of Homeland Security respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. I know you understand the gravity of the situation that resulted in your declaration of a National Emergency on 13 March 2020. This is an event of not only national, but international, importance.

This request is essential for the preservation of life and property. This pandemic triggered the need to perform mass medical screening to determine who may be infected so they may be treated and quarantined to prevent additional spread of this disease across the State and Nation. Additionally, the state of Florida has faced the requirement to accept potentially infected interstate and international travelers at its many airports and ports, and handle screening, and in some cases transportation, medical care, and quarantine of those individuals.

I am also concerned that while we attempt to reduce the spread of this disease by limiting movement of our citizens, we are limiting access to commodities. This has the potential to be exacerbated by hoarding and a reduction in long-haul delivery capacity caused by illness and self-quarantine. As a result, the Florida National Guard will be tasked to secure facilities, deliver and distribute food and water, and potentially to quell uprisings. Finally, Florida has a large percentage of the population who are at a higher risk of suffering the serious effects of this disease, which raises concerns that our medical facilities may run out of capacity. As a result of these effects, Florida requires immediate capability and capacity for the following lifelines: Safety and Security; Transportation; and Health and Medical. Specific capabilities requested include: Logistics; Command and Control; Security; Medical; and Transportation.

Due to the sensitive nature of this request, the aforementioned resources are needed within the current operational period. I intend to utilize multiple Florida National Guard units to fulfill immediate requirements. The Florida National Guard is uniquely qualified to provide assistance as our units are spread throughout the State, in close proximity to ongoing response efforts, and possess the capabilities to perform the missions outlined above. The Florida National Guard is also closely tied and intimately

familiar with other responding agencies through their many years of practice during disaster responses in our State.

Florida's economy is largely based on tourism, which has been a necessary casualty of this pandemic. By authorizing Florida National Guard personnel to be federally funded, while remaining under State command and control, pursuant to this request, you will alleviate some of the economic impact that we are already experiencing and allow Florida to avoid the reimbursement process that has historically taken many months. This will free up the necessary resources to allow additional State-funded response efforts.

Finally, by placing National Guard Soldiers and Airmen under 502(f), you will best sustain force readiness by providing Guard members, infected while responding to the pandemic, access to DoD Medical Treatment Facilities. This will allow rapid recovery and ensure our service members are ready for future federal support.

I greatly appreciate your consideration of this request, your support of the state of Florida, and your continued leadership.

Team DMS-

Governor DeSantis, with support from our agencies across the enterprise, has worked aggressively for the last three weeks to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in Florida.

Together, we are working to rapidly respond to a situation that is evolving minute by minute. Thank you for all you are doing to help respond.

The Governor recognizes and understands that many of our team members are concerned for the health and well-being of themselves, their families, their colleagues, and their communities.

That's where each of you come in. Never has it been more important for you to display calm and patient leadership, to be supportive and encouraging to co-workers, and customers, and to clearly and frequently communicate clear and accurate information.

I also need you to know that this is not a sprint, it's a marathon. I know many of you are burning the candle at both ends. Pace yourselves. Have balance in your lives – get some sleep, go for a walk, and eat properly.

With that, I want to highlight some important options the Governor has put in place for our employees and I want you to make sure this message is heard by every team member.

1. Telework

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Governor is offering state employees the flexibility to telework if possible. You should speak with your supervisor if you have not already.

2. Leave

The Governor directed DMS to waive rules governing use of leave. Why is that important?

It's important because if schools are closed, day care centers are closed, or elderly parents are homebound because this virus afflicts the most vulnerable, we want our team members **to use whatever leave is available** to them to help take care of their families. (Annual, sick, special comp, and regular comp leave is available for use.)

The Governor also directed DMS to waive rules governing the transfer of sick leave. Employees can now donate leave across agencies to others even if they are not family.

3. Safety

DMS continues to implement measures to ensure the health and safety of those currently working within state-maintained buildings including: increasing the cleaning of public spaces and high touch areas, installing additional hand sanitizer stations in high traffic areas, and providing guidance to facilities managed outside of the DMS portfolio.

We continue to disseminate guidance provided by public health officials related to social distancing and are monitoring building closures throughout the state.

4. Closing Buildings to Visitors

The Governor understands that social distancing is critical to stopping the spread of this virus. That's why DMS is limiting access to visitors in all DMS-managed facilities. Finally, don't forget the Employee Assistance Program. If you or your coworkers are under stress or struggling, we should be connecting them to the free resources available. We will soon be distributing a flyer with the method to utilize this resource.

Thank you for all that you do. I appreciate you. The Governor appreciates you. We can't do this without your help.

Agency GCs – thank you each for attending our call this afternoon. I very much appreciate all of your hard work and effort during this time. For clarification on our COVID-19 response, I'm providing the outline that I discussed to ensure we have a process in place that allows you to serve your agency client and to serve the Governor.

1. All written legal documents - from an Agency Executive Order to Agency enforcement guidance - should be approved in the normal protocol up through your Deputy General Counsel in the Governor's legal office. I emphasized this point to ensure we are reviewing everything that is legal interpretation and legal guidance related to COVID-19... likewise, our legal office has no required protocol for approval of non-legal documents.
2. Continue to work with the Deputy General Counsel to determine the proper vehicle of legal actions, whether for example an Agency EO or Agency FAQs.
3. Continue to work with the Deputy General Counsel to reconcile, when possible, extensions, delays, etc. to the Governor's EO which expires, unless extended, 60 days from March 9.
4. In a State of Emergency, our Governor's legal office adds an additional review beyond the Deputy General Counsel, by either Nick Primrose with his EOC responsibilities or myself.
5. Regardless of what approval we provide for legal review, your agency must follow its other chain-of-command requirements whether through Chief of Staffs or Communications. You certainly can be helpful to inform and promote those processes.

TALLAHASSEE —The Florida Department of Health has announced a new positive case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in Florida. To keep Florida residents and visitors safe

and aware about the status of the virus, the Department is issuing regular updates as information becomes available.

New Positive Case

- A 69-year old female in Broward County has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual is isolated and will remain isolated until cleared by public health officials.

Advisory on Port Everglades

- The Department, through an extensive epidemiological investigation, identified this new case as the third positive case of COVID-19 associated with Port Everglades in Broward County, Florida. Further, all three cases are connected to or employed by Metro Cruise Services – a company that operates at Port Everglades.
- The Florida Department of Health recommends all individuals experiencing symptoms who have recently travelled through Port Everglades to immediately contact their County Health Department or health care provider and self-isolate for 14 Days.
- The Department also recommends employees of Metro Cruise Services at Port Everglades with any association to these cases self-isolate at home.
- The Department is working to connect with all employees at Metro Cruise Services who may have come into contact with the three individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 to provide the employees with the appropriate guidance and monitoring.
- The department is working in close consultation with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on this investigation.
- The CDC recommends that individuals with recent travel history on a cruise to monitor their health for 14 days and, if they develop symptoms, to immediately self-isolate and contact their County Health Department or health care provider.

Tallahassee, Fla. — The Florida Department of Health has announced updates regarding the 2019 coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in Florida. Two individuals have died and two new presumptive positive cases have been identified in Broward County.

Deceased Individuals

- A previously announced COVID-19 patient in Santa Rosa County has died, following an international trip.
- A new case of a COVID-19 patient in her seventies in Lee County has died, following an international trip.

New Presumptive Positive Cases

- A 75-year old male in Broward County has been identified as a presumptive positive. This person is isolated and will continue to remain isolated until cleared by public health officials.
- A 65-year old male in Broward County has been identified as a presumptive positive. This person is isolated and will continue to remain isolated until cleared by public health officials.

The Florida Department of Health is working closely with the patients, potential close contacts of each case and health care providers to isolate and monitor persons who may have been exposed to COVID-19 and implement testing of anyone who may develop COVID-19 symptoms, including fever, cough or shortness of breath.

COVID-19 can spread from person to person through small droplets from the nose or mouth, including when an individual coughs or sneezes. These droplets may land on objects and surfaces. Other people may contract COVID-19 by touching these objects or surfaces, then touching their eyes, nose or mouth.

Symptoms of COVID-19 are fever, cough and shortness of breath. Symptoms may appear in as few as two days or as many as 14 days following exposure. Most people recover from the COVID-19 without needing special treatment. The elderly and those with underlying medical problems like high blood pressure, heart problems and diabetes, are more likely to develop serious illness.

There is currently no vaccine to prevent COVID-19. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. As a reminder, the Department always recommends everyday preventive actions to help impede the spread of respiratory diseases, including:

- Avoiding close contact with people who are sick;
- Staying home when you are sick and avoiding contact with persons in poor health;
- Avoiding touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands;
- Covering your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then disposing of the tissue;
- Washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing;
 - If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty; and
- Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.

The CDC does not recommend that asymptomatic, healthy people wear a facemask to protect themselves from respiratory diseases, including COVID-19. Facemasks should be used by people who show symptoms of COVID-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others. The use of facemasks is also crucial for health workers and people who are taking care of someone in close settings (at home or in a health care facility).

A person that experiences a fever and symptoms of respiratory illness, such as fever, cough or shortness of breath, within 14 days after travel from China, Italy, Iran, South Korea, Japan and any other destination under CDC travel advisory should call ahead to their health care provider and local county health department (CHD) and mention their recent travel or close contact.

If a person has had close contact with someone showing these symptoms who has recently traveled from this area or been in contact with a person with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19, they should call ahead to a health care professional and the county health department. The health care professional will work with the Department to determine if the person should be tested for COVID-19.

Team DMS-

Governor DeSantis, with support from our agencies across the enterprise, has worked aggressively for the last three weeks to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in Florida.

Together, we are working to rapidly respond to a situation that is evolving minute by minute. Thank you for all you are doing to help respond.

The Governor recognizes and understands that many of our team members are concerned for the health and well-being of themselves, their families, their colleagues, and their communities.

That's where each of you come in. Never has it been more important for you to display calm and patient leadership, to be supportive and encouraging to co-workers, and customers, and to clearly and frequently communicate clear and accurate information.

I also need you to know that this is not a sprint, it's a marathon. I know many of you are burning the candle at both ends. Pace yourselves. Have balance in your lives – get some sleep, go for a walk, and eat properly.

With that, I want to highlight some important options the Governor has put in place for our employees and I want you to make sure this message is heard by every team member.

1. Telework

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Governor is offering state employees the

flexibility to telework if possible. You should speak with your supervisor if you have not already.

2. Leave

The Governor directed DMS to waive rules governing use of leave. Why is that important?

It's important because if schools are closed, day care centers are closed, or elderly parents are homebound because this virus afflicts the most vulnerable, we want our team members to **use whatever leave is available** to them to help take care of their families. (Annual, sick, special comp, and regular comp leave is available for use.)

The Governor also directed DMS to waive rules governing the transfer of sick leave. Employees can now donate leave across agencies to others even if they are not family.

3. Safety

DMS continues to implement measures to ensure the health and safety of those currently working within state-maintained buildings including: increasing the cleaning of public spaces and high touch areas, installing additional hand sanitizer stations in high traffic areas, and providing guidance to facilities managed outside of the DMS portfolio.

We continue to disseminate guidance provided by public health officials related to social distancing and are monitoring building closures throughout the state.

4. Closing Buildings to Visitors

The Governor understands that social distancing is critical to stopping the spread of this virus. That's why DMS is limiting access to visitors in all DMS-managed facilities.

Finally, don't forget the Employee Assistance Program. If you or your coworkers are under stress or struggling, we should be connecting them to the free resources available. We will soon be distributing a flyer with the method to utilize this resource.

Thank you for all that you do. I appreciate you. The Governor appreciates you. We can't do this without your help.

Dear Mr. President:

Under the provisions of Section 401 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C §§5121-5207 (the "Stafford Act"), as implemented by 44 C.F.R. §206.36, I request that you declare a Major Disaster for the State of Florida to include certain programs under Individual Assistance: *Disaster Unemployment Assistance, Crisis Counseling, Community Disaster Loans and the Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Program* as a result of COVID-19 Response for the Incident Period beginning January 20, 2020 for all sixty-seven (67) counties. This request is timely under 44 CFR §206.36(a). FEMA Form 010-0-13 is included with this request.

On March 1, 2020, I issued Executive Order 20-51, directing Florida's Surgeon General and State Health Officer to declare a public health emergency due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Florida's Surgeon General declared a public health emergency on the same day. On March 7, 2020, I directed the Director of the Division of Emergency Management to activate the State Emergency Operations Center to Level 2 to provide additional coordination and response to COVID-19. On March 9, 2020, I issued Executive Order 20-52 declaring a State of Emergency for the entire state of Florida due to COVID-19.

On March 13, 2020, you declared the ongoing Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant an Emergency Declaration for all states, tribes, territories, and the District of Columbia pursuant to section 501(b) of the Stafford Act. In accordance with the Emergency Declaration for COVID-19, eligible emergency protective measures taken to respond to the COVID-19 emergency at the direction or guidance of public health officials may be reimbursed under Category B of the agency's Public Assistance Program. Reimbursable activities typically include emergency protective measures, such as the activation of

State Emergency Operations Center, National Guard costs, law enforcement, and other measures necessary to protect public health and safety. FEMA assistance will be provided at a 75-percent Federal cost share.

At this time, I am requesting that you include the following Individual Assistance Programs in your Declaration: Disaster Unemployment Assistance, Crisis Counseling, Community Disaster Loans, and the Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Program. The foregoing analysis supports the inclusion of these Individual Assistance Programs in a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Florida.

Factors for the Individual Assistance Program

Per 44 C.F.R. 206.48(b), the factors FEMA will consider to measure the severity, magnitude, and impact of the disaster and to evaluate the need for assistance to individuals under the Stafford Act include the following:

1. State Fiscal Capacity and Resources Availability;
2. Uninsured Home and Personal Property Losses;
3. Disaster Impacted Population Profile;
4. Impact to Community Infrastructure;
5. Casualties; and
6. Disaster-Related Unemployment.

Given the nature of this event and constantly changing information, the State of Florida offers the following data to support its request and to make a showing of the presence of the above factors.

1. State Fiscal Capacity and Resources Availability

The State has currently allocated all available resources to the effort to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and is in direct support of response efforts, while experiencing significant impact to the economy of Florida. Current projected State coordination and response actions total more than \$208,778,682 in services and materials and supplies, not including direct expenses of local political subdivisions or supporting private entities. Resources of local governments and supporting private entities are strained and financial resources that were reasonably expected to be at the State's disposal to respond are being affected by the impact to the economy of the State. Business revenue and tax receipts are suffering and without supplemental federal assistance, the State's ability to sufficiently respond to and recover from this event will be severely impacted.

The State's efforts to address this shortfall include the allocation of \$50,000,000 to the Emergency Bridge Loan Program that will provide interest-free, short-term loans to small businesses that experienced a financial impact from COVID-19. On March 15, 2020, I requested a Small Business Administration (SBA) Declaration authorizing the Economic Injury Damage Loan Program for the COVID-19 response. This request was granted on March 18, 2020. As of March 20, 2020, 6,617 business have reported negative impacts to the State Department of Economic Opportunity with many reporting closures and severe reductions in sales and income. The SBA determined this was necessary and appropriate given the showing of substantial economic damage to Florida's businesses.

2. Uninsured Home and Personal Property Losses

The State is not requesting the activation of the Individuals and Households Program; therefore, the requested Home and Personal Property Loss data is not applicable.

3. Disaster Impacted Population Profile

One of the key demographics of interest during this event is the age of the State's population. Florida is proud of its large elderly population, as according to the US Census Bureau, persons 65 years and over make up roughly 20.5% of Florida's population. Florida's elderly population is expected to grow, more so than any other age demographic. Early reports and guidance about COVID-19 references disproportionate impacts of the virus to this demographic. This event is anticipated to have a wide-reaching impact on the fiscal health of our State's healthcare infrastructure. Seniors citizens are particularly significantly impacted by the COVID-19 virus and to this point, the State estimates 16% of persons under the age of 65 are without health insurance.

The State has seen an increase in COVID-19 cases at nursing homes and assisted living facilities (ALF) with 109 cases under investigation in these facility types and 21 cases reported. Although the State has been instituting strict measures to prevent further infections, it is extremely likely COVID-19 will continue to spread and impact the elderly population statewide.

4. Impact to Community Infrastructure

COVID-19 has had, and continues to have, a drastic effect on community infrastructure. Hospitals, medical facilities, and first responders are facing challenges rarely experienced before. The process of triaging and isolating potentially affected individuals is significantly disrupting lifesaving and life-sustaining services. Additionally, the insufficient medical resources and capacities of medical facilities, and the already limited number of qualified medical personnel will only continue to rapidly deplete as the impacts of COVID-19 continue to spread.

5. Casualties

As of March 22, 2020, the Florida Department of Health has 13 casualties as a direct result of the COVID-19 virus. While the State is doing everything in its power to prevent further casualties, more are expected.

6. Disaster-Related Unemployment

On March 12, 2020, I activated the Florida Business Damage Assessment Survey, an online platform for all businesses to report economic damage incurred by COVID-19. In this survey, businesses shared current economic losses, anticipated economic losses, as well as how many employees that the business had already laid off and how many employees the business anticipated to lay off. Of the previously referenced 6,617 businesses that have completed the survey, more than half of those businesses reported that employees have been laid off due to the negative impact that COVID-19 has had on its business. Those businesses report having to lay off a total of 40,438

persons; 31,246 temporarily and 9,192 permanently. New businesses are inputting data on a daily basis.

During this unprecedented time, states are experiencing a high volume of calls and applications for Reemployment Assistance and the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) is seeing historic increases in filings. Last week, DEO received 5,325 applications for Reemployment Assistance, whereas they saw 4,853 applications in the prior week. Call volume to DEO for the past Monday – Thursday was more than 130,000 calls whereas last week they had approximately 28,000 calls for the entire week.

For these reasons, I ask that you include Disaster Unemployment Assistance, Crisis Counseling, Community Disaster Loans, and the Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Program in a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Florida.

Additional Assistance Requested

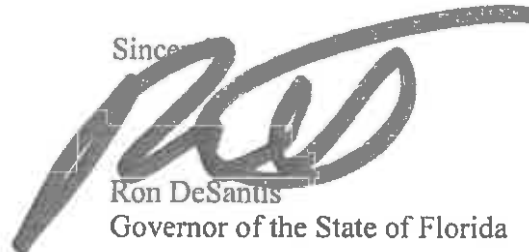
In addition to the FEMA Individual Assistance Programs referenced above (Disaster Unemployment Assistance, Crisis Counseling, Community Disaster Loans, and the Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Program), the State requests the following of FEMA:

- Increase the small project threshold for FEMA Public Assistance to \$250,000 and authorize the ability to amend outside of the limited circumstances outlined in the Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide as needed.
- Extend the application deadline for an additional 90 days for the Homeland Security Grant Program, Non-Profit Security Grant Program, and the Emergency Management Grant Program as state and local partners are fully dedicated to the current mission of responding to the COVID-19 impacts.
- Suspend appeal deadlines for the FEMA Public Assistance Program for 90 days to allow for resources that are currently dedicated to responding to COVID-19 to remain engaged in that task without negatively impacting their appeal opportunities. This includes suspending appeal decisions concerning timeliness of appeals for both Recipients and Subrecipients.
- Suspend deadlines for all pending and current Requests for Information (RFI) for the FEMA Public Assistance Program to allow for resources that are currently dedicated to responding to COVID-19 to remain engaged in that task without negatively impacting their ability to respond timely.
- Suspend the issuance of new determination memos for the FEMA Public Assistance Program for failure to respond to any RFIs or submit any other documentation as requested due to response efforts for COVID-19. This request also includes suspending issuances of determination memos finding costs or Applicants ineligible for FEMA Public Assistance funding.

- Extend periods of performance, to include time extensions, for the completion of all projects under the FEMA Public Assistance Program.

Conclusion

The State is requesting the activation of the following FEMA programs: *Disaster Unemployment Assistance, Crisis Counseling, Community Disaster Loans, and the Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Program*, and the relief from regulatory burdens outlined in the bullets above. For administrative processing purposes, all information that would be included in required Enclosure A (Individual Assistance) has been incorporated into the cover letter. Further, I have designated Jared Moskowitz, Director of the Florida Division of Emergency Management, as the State Coordinating Officer for this emergency. He is authorized to provide further information, assurances, requests, or justification on my behalf.

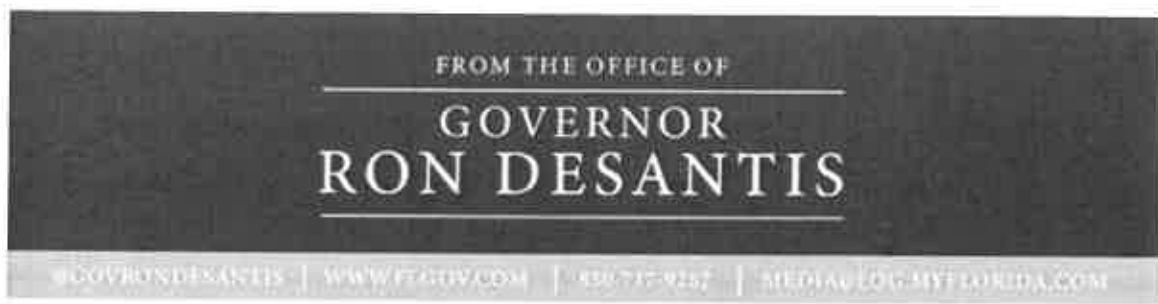

> I was just notified that we currently have 4 FLNG Soldiers in isolation due to either exposure to COVID-positive patients prior to being activated to State Active Duty, or due to exhibiting COVID symptoms since they were activated.

> We're working through the details, but this is a scenario we have been preparing for, and is not unexpected. If we were able to activate them under 502(f) authority, they would be eligible for federal benefits instead of the state's Workman's Comp, which would be a better scenario for the Soldier and the State of Florida. If they get ill from the virus and require extensive treatment, the federal benefits afforded by a 502(f) activation could be substantial. The attached info paper discusses the issue in greater detail.

> Every TAG in the nation is pushing to get the Feds to authorize 502(f) since this situation is only going to get worse with time. I encourage Governor DeSantis to continue to support this initiative and will be presenting him with a letter tomorrow requesting his endorsement for this as well.
