Enclosed with this letter is the United States Agency for International Development's (USAID) production of one (1) page that was sent to DoS for consultation in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request.

On April 8, 2020, you requested the following:

1. All email communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, or calendar invitations) sent by John Barsa to any email addressed ending in .com/.net/.org/.edu/.mail; and
2. Email communications sent by Mr. Barsa during his time serving in any positions – including Assistant Administrator for USAID's Bureau for Latin America and the Caribbean and Acting Administrator - are considered responsive to this request.

In an email dated April 20, 2020, you amended your request to add the following:

All electronic calendars or calendar entries for John Barsa, including any calendars maintained on his behalf, reflecting events that took place from June 10, 2019, to the date the search is conducted. Calendars maintained for or by Mr. Barsa during his time serving in any USAID positions—including Assistant Administrator for USAID's Bureau for Latin America and the Caribbean and Acting Administrator—are considered responsive to this request. The search will be limited to electronic records from emails and calendars.

In addition, you agreed to close FOIA request F-00167 because it is being addressed with F-00168-20.

The time frame provided for the requested records is June 10, 2019 through the date the search is conducted.

To date we have conducted a search of the Bureau for Management, Office of the Chief Information Officer (M/CIO) for documents responsive to your request. USAID has completed its processing of records and is transmitting the records that were sent for consultation as they are returned to the Agency.

We received a response from DoS regarding 1 page that was transmitted for consultation. It is released in part pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(5), (b)(6) and (b)(7)(E).
