All official or unofficial policy directives, guidance documents (including Official Election Bulletins (OEBs) issued by Elections Director Chris Harvey), and decision memoranda regarding the requirement for Georgia voters to bear the cost of their own postage when submitting absentee vote-by-mail ballots in the Presidential Preference Primary.¹

Please provide all responsive records from March 15, 2020, through the date the search is conducted.

Please notify American Oversight of any anticipated fees or costs in excess of \$100 prior to incurring such costs or fees.
