This email responds to the request you filed for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) received by the Federal Election Commission's (FEC) FOIA Requester Service Center on May 4, 2020. Your request sought

“All communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, text messages, calendar invitations, and attachments thereto) between (a) Commissioners Hunter, Walther, Weintraub and Petersen; anyone serving as General Counsel; anyone serving as Staff Director; or anyone serving as Chief of Staff to the aforementioned officials and (b) any representatives or employees of the White House (including anyone with communicating with an email address ending in who.eop.gov) *regarding* any candidate or candidates running for election or reelection to any federal office in November 2020 (including candidates in primary elections seeking a party's nomination for a candidacy in the November 2020 election).”
