Dear American Oversight:

This responds your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests dated and received in this Office on February 13, 2020, in which you requested various records pertaining to Michael Flynn and the review of his criminal investigation and prosecution since February 29, 2020.

Please be advised that this Office has previously processed a related FOIA request that had become the subject of litigation. The records disclosed in response to that matter have been posted to our FOIA Library (<https://www.justice.gov/oip/available-documents-oip#processed>) under the heading "Records Concerning Roger Stone and Related to the Cases of *United States v. Roger Stone* and *United States v. Michael Flynn*." I trust that this material satisfies your requests.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2018). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

If you submit your appeal by mail, both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
