Mr. Evers:

This responds to your FOIA request dated 22 May 2020 and received by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on 28 May 2020. Pursuant to the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, you requested:

1. *“Any transcripts or recordings of phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016.”*
2. *All derived intelligence reports (such as signals intelligence reports or comparable intelligence reports, including minimized reporting) reflecting the contents of any phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016.*
3. *All call detail records (CDRs) or other metadata of phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016.*
4. *Any purge records or requests affecting any records of phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016.”*

Your request was processed under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. After a thorough search in our records and databases, we were unable to locate any records responsive to your request.
