This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received in the office of the Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA) on May 26, 2020, requesting, pursuant to FOIA, any records pertaining to any transcripts or recordings of phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016; all derived intelligence reports (such as signals intelligence reports or comparable intelligence reports, including minimized reporting) reflecting the contents of any phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016; all call detail records (CDRs) or other metadata of phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016; and any purge records or requests affecting any records of phone calls between Russian Ambassador Sergey Kislyak and Michael T. Flynn from December 2016.

DCSA located no records responsive to your request. Please note that this request does not fall under the scope of the mission of DCSA.
