This letter responds to your 25 June 2020 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, seeking records from May 25, 2020 through June 5, 2020 related to public reports indicating that President Trump solicited the service of numerous federal law enforcement agencies to help control the protests incited by the May 25, 2020 killing of George Floyd in Minneapolis:

The U.S. Army Office of the Provost Marshal General (OPMG) conducted a search of the requested information and, after conferring with our Law Enforcement Division no responsive records were found. The Army National Guard Bureau, is currently processing your FOIA request under FOIA # J-20-0150 and will respond to you directly with their findings.
