This is the sixth interim response to your client's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), dated September 10, 2020, given the tracking number 2020-ICLI-00061. Your clients are seeking the following: various records relating to the decision to deploy federal law enforcement officers in response to protests, the use of force on protesters, and the refusal of some federal law enforcement officers to identify themselves.

ICE has considered this request under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and processed the remaining 315 pages of potentially responsive records from the Directors Office. Upon review ICE has determined that all 315 pages were duplicative or non-responsive.
