Dear Mr. Evers:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated August 25, 2020 in which you seek access to Postal Service records. Specifically, you requested: All email communications (including emails, complete email chains, calendar invitations, and attachments thereto) between (a) Postal Board of Governors Chairman Robert "Mike" Duncan and (b) anyone communicating from an email address ending in americancrossroads.org or senateleadershipfund.org, or Steven Law, between March 1, 2020, and the date the search is conducted.

A search was conducted of the records maintained by the Board of Governors. However, despite this diligent search, we were unable to locate responsive documents.

If you are not satisfied with the response to this request, you may file an administrative appeal within 90 days of the date of this response letter by writing to

Your appeal must be postmarked or electronically transmitted within 90 days of the date of the response to your request.

The letter of appeal should include, as applicable:

- (1) A copy of the request, of any notification of denial or other action, and of any other related correspondence;
- (2) The FOIA tracking number assigned to the request;
- (3) A statement of the action, or failure to act, from which the appeal is taken;
- (4) A statement identifying the specific redactions to responsive records that the requester is challenging;
- (5) A statement of the relief sought; and
- (6) A statement of the reasons why the requester believes the action or failure to act is erroneous.
