This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated October 15, 202 (received on March 4, 2021), stating that, "[i]n the event the agency doesn't have a copy of above the contract (that was listed in FA-21-0087), any other records in your possession that reflect the terms of the contract/agreement btw ATI and Novavax." FOIA reference number for this request is FP-21-011796/FA-21-0088.

The Army Contracting Command, Natick Division searched their records and determined that the requested records do not exist.

If you consider this response to be an adverse action, you may administratively appeal, in writing, to the Secretary of the Army.
