This is in further response to your November 13, 2020 Freedom of Information Act request, received by the Civil Rights Division, seeking access to:

"All orders, directives, or guidance provided to the offices of U.S. Attorneys regarding potential investigations, evaluations, reviews, or probes into cases of election fraud, ballot fraud, or voter fraud, or otherwise concerning the enforcement of election-related laws" from October 8, 2020, to the present.

After a thorough search, I have determined that the Civil Rights Division has no records pertaining to the subject of your request.
