location. Poll monitors are not allowed to talk to auditors or county staff members. Poll monitors can talk to county supervisors and ask them questions.

At best, poll monitors can randomly inspect the auditing activities but not able to confirm with confidence that all ballots are being counted correctly. This is especially true when the in-person advance ballots were being audited because the font on the ballot is so small and we can't read the actual voter's choice on each ballot and can't watch 10 teams adequately at all times.
