BIOGRAPHIES



Dr. Robert Kadlec, Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services

Dr. Robert Kadlec is the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR) at the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS). The ASPR serves as the Secretary's principal advisor on matters related to public health emergencies, including bioterrorism. The office leads the nation in preventing, responding to and recovering from the adverse health effects of manmade and naturally occurring disasters and public health emergencies. As such, the office coordinates interagency activities between HHS, other federal agencies, and state and local officials responsible for emergency preparedness and the protection of the civilian population from public health emergencies.

Dr. Kadlec spent more than 20 years as a career officer and physician in the United States Air Force before retiring as a Colonel. Over the course of his career, he has held senior positions in the White House, the U.S. Senate, and the Department of Defense. Most recently, he served as the Deputy Staff Director to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence.

Dr. Kadlec previously served as staff director for Senator Richard Burr's subcommittee on bioterrorism and public health in the 109th Congress. In that capacity, he was instrumental in drafting the Pandemic and All-Hazard Preparedness Bill which was signed into law to improve the nation's public health and medical preparedness and response capabilities for emergencies, whether deliberate, accidental, or natural. Dr. Kadlec also served at the White House from 2002 to 2005 as director for biodefense on the Homeland Security Council, where he was responsible for conducting the biodefense end-to-end assessment, which culminated in drafting the National Biodefense Policy for the 21st Century. He served as Special Assistant to President George W. Bush for Biodefense Policy from 2007 to 2009.

Earlier in his career, he served as the Special Advisor for Counterproliferation Policy at the Office of the Secretary of Defense, where he assisted DOD efforts to counter chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear (CBRN) threats in the wake of 9/11 and contributed to the FBI investigation of the anthrax letter attacks. He began his career as a flight surgeon for the 16th Special Operations Wing and subsequently served as a surgeon for the 24th Special Tactics Squadron and as Special Assistant to J-2 for Chemical and Biological Warfare at the Joint Special Operations Command. He was named U.S. Air Force Flight Surgeon of the Year in 1986.



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Dr. Kadlec holds a bachelor's degree from the United States Air Force Academy, a doctorate of medicine and a master's degree in tropical medicine and hygiene from the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences, as well as a master's degree in national security studies from Georgetown University.



**Dr. Stephen Redd, Director, Office of Public Health
Preparedness and Response, The Centers for Disease
Control and Prevention**

Dr. Stephen C. Redd, MD (RADM, USPHS) directs the CDC's Office of Public Health Preparedness and Response, where he is responsible for state and local readiness, emergency operations, select agents and toxins and the nation's cache of emergency medical countermeasures. He is also a rear admiral in the U.S. Public Health Service and an assistant surgeon general. As a medical doctor and epidemiologist with 30 years of service at CDC, Dr. Redd has served as the senior leader on many high profile emergency responses for the agency. Dr. Redd now directs emergency response activities across CDC and with local, state, tribal, national, territorial, and international public health partners.

Dr. Redd was the incident commander for the 2009 H1N1 pandemic response. In this role he was responsible for leading CDC's efforts to keep Americans healthy and safe from this pandemic threat. Dr. Redd set two priorities for this response: to collect and analyze disease information to understand the situation, and to make vaccines available to everyone who wanted to be vaccinated. Overseeing the over 3,000 CDC staff who participated in this response, Dr. Redd ensured that CDC, in coordination with its partners, was able to most effectively address and stop the H1N1 outbreak. This nearly yearlong effort remains one of the longest activations of CDC's emergency operations center and the response helped build the current infrastructure for responding to wide-scale outbreaks in the United States.

As a board certified doctor and trained Epidemic Intelligent Service (EIS) officer, Dr. Redd has taken part in multiple disease outbreak investigations and responses ranging from Legionnaires' disease outbreaks, strategic development for the control of malaria, and work on the elimination of measles in the United States.

Dr. Redd's first role at CDC was a summer job working in reproductive health that he took after his second year of medical school. He started this job the summer of 1981, the same year the first cases of AIDS were diagnosed. After completing medical school and his residency, Dr. Redd returned to CDC to participate in the EIS program where he had the opportunity to travel to Senegal to assess the feasibility of conducting a pneumococcal vaccine trial in Dakar. Following his EIS training, Dr. Redd took a job in CDC's International



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Health Program Office; today known as the Center for Global Health. In this role he worked on childhood survival projects for 3 years in Africa on acute respiratory infections and malaria. In his next assignment, he led efforts to eliminate measles from the United States. Dr. Redd also led CDC's efforts to reduce the burden of asthma in the United States while in CDC's National Center of Environmental Health. Before becoming the director of the Office of Public Health Preparedness and Response, Dr. Redd was the director of the Influenza Coordination Unit. In addition to serving as incident commander for the 2009 H1N1 response, Dr. Redd helped establish CDC's Pandemic Influenza Task Force with the mission to provide leadership for the agency's highest priority; pandemic planning and preparedness.

Dr. Redd has authored more than 120 scientific publications and received numerous awards, including the Public Health Service Distinguished Service Medal and the Meritorious Service Medal. He received his baccalaureate degree in history from Princeton University and his medical degree with honors at the Emory University School of Medicine. He trained in medicine at Johns Hopkins Hospital and completed the 2 year Epidemic Intelligence Service training program at CDC.

Alex Azar, Secretary, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services

Alex M. Azar II was sworn in as the 24th Secretary of Health and Human Services on January 25, 2018. He has spent his career working in both the public and private sectors, as an attorney and in senior leadership roles focused on advancing healthcare reform, research, and innovation.

Secretary Azar has laid out three guiding strategies for HHS's programs: facilitating patient-centered healthcare markets, protecting life and lives, and promoting independence.

While at HHS, Secretary Azar has developed and led President Trump's vision for healthcare: a patient-centric, affordable, personalized system that puts the patient in control and treats the patient like a human being, not like a number. He has pioneered a patient-centered approach to the value-based transformation of the American healthcare system, including through transparency around price and quality, outcomes-based payments, interoperable health IT, provider collaboration, and unprecedented regulatory relief that places patients over paperwork. Under his tenure, HHS has transformed the pharmaceutical marketplace, driving down drug prices through a comprehensive drug pricing strategy and approval of historic levels of generic, brand, and biosimilar drugs. The Department has also worked to make health insurance more affordable and created more options for Americans who lack employer-based insurance.

Under President Trump's leadership, HHS has helped turn around the rising rate of deaths from opioid overdoses through a comprehensive, science and evidence-based approach. Secretary Azar launched President Trump's historic effort to end the HIV epidemic in America. With Azar's leadership, the department is also tackling maternal mortality and gaps in rural healthcare, as well as bringing new hope to people suffering from kidney disease and addressing key social determinants of health. A key part of Secretary Azar's agenda has been protecting the nation against infectious disease threats such as Ebola, influenza, and measles, ensuring the United States is prepared for manmade and naturally occurring disasters and threats, and leading global efforts to protect public health. Secretary Azar has also been a leading advocate to keep e-cigarettes out of the hands of our children.

Under Secretary Azar, HHS has worked to empower able-bodied adults receiving Medicaid through community engagement and restored the focus of human service programs to promoting independence, dignity, and work. HHS has also championed efforts to improve access and care for those suffering from serious mental illness.

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His current tenure at HHS is a second tour of duty at the Department, after serving as its General Counsel from 2001 to 2005 and then as Deputy Secretary from 2005 to 2007.

From 2007 through January 2017, Azar was a senior executive at Eli Lilly and Company in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Azar clerked for U.S. Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia before practicing law for several years.

He graduated summa cum laude with a bachelor's degree in economics and government from Dartmouth College and earned his law degree from Yale University.



Paul Ostrowski, Director for Supply, Production, and Distribution, Operation Warp Speed

Lieutenant General (Retired) Paul Ostrowski is a member of the Army Senior Executive Service and currently serves as the Director of Supply, Production, and Distribution for Operation Warp Speed (OWS). OWS is the President's Task Force charged with an unprecedented mission of rapidly delivering 300 million doses of safe COVID-19 vaccine to the American people by January 2021. Mr. Ostrowski supports the OWS Chief Operating Officer by synchronizing efforts and capabilities across the private sector and leading an interagency civilian and military team charged with ensuring the successful manufacturing, distribution, and administration of approved therapeutics and vaccines valued at over \$16 billion.

Mr. Ostrowski, is a 35 year veteran of the United States Army and has a record of exceptional results in demanding, high-pressure environments. He is uniquely skilled in developing strategic plans, changing organizational cultures, and implementing vision leading to innovative outcomes. He possesses extensive experience in developing acquisition and contracting strategies and executing strategic planning for major defense research, development, test, evaluation, and procurement programs. Mr. Ostrowski has a proven ability to cultivate high-performing teams and foster collaboration among stakeholders to achieve strategic objectives. He is a visionary leader with extensive Congressional experience including fellowships, member and staffer information sharing and testimony.

His final assignment on active duty was as the Principal Military Deputy and Director of the Army Acquisition Corps. He led a workforce of more than 39,500 professionals while providing oversight for more than 720 diverse acquisition programs including aviation, ground



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combat vehicles, precision fires, network, and air defense systems with a combined portfolio of \$36 billion.

Mr. Ostrowski earned a Bachelor of Science in Geography from the United States Military Academy at West Point, a Master of Science in Systems Acquisition Management from the Naval Post Graduate School, and a Master of Science in National Resource Strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces/Eisenhower School in Washington D.C. He is a combat veteran and member of the Army Special Forces Community.

Mr. Ostrowski is the proud father of one son, Brandon, who is a border patrol agent in Yuma, Arizona.

BIOGRAPHY



Dr. Robert Redfield, Director, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention

Robert R. Redfield, MD, is the 18th Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Administrator of the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry. He has been a public health leader actively engaged in clinical research and clinical care of chronic human viral infections and infectious diseases, especially HIV, for more than 30 years.

He served as the founding director of the Department of Retroviral Research within the U.S. Military's HIV Research Program, and retired after 20 years of service in the U.S. Army Medical Corps. Following his military service, he co-founded the University of Maryland's Institute of Human Virology with Dr. William

Blattner and Dr. Robert C. Gallo and served as the Chief of Infectious Diseases and Vice Chair of Medicine at the University of Maryland School of Medicine.

Dr. Redfield made several important early contributions to the scientific understanding of HIV, including the demonstration of the importance of heterosexual transmission, the development of the Walter Reed staging system for HIV infection, and the demonstration of active HIV replication in all stages of HIV infection.

In addition to his research work, Dr. Redfield oversaw an extensive clinical program providing HIV care and treatment to more than 5,000 patients in the Baltimore/Washington, D.C. community.

Dr. Redfield served as a member of the President's Advisory Council on HIV/AIDS from 2005 to 2009, and was appointed as Chair of the International Subcommittee from 2006 to 2009.

He is a past member of the Office of AIDS Research Advisory Council at the National Institutes of Health, the Fogarty International Center Advisory Board at the National Institutes of Health, and the Advisory Anti-Infective Agent Committee of the Food and Drug Administration.
