Under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, agencies are required to produce records responsive to a request in accordance with statutory time frames and subject to certain exemptions. - (2) The FOIA tracking number assigned to the request;
- (3) A statement of the action, or failure to act, from which the appeal is taken;

- (5) A statement of the relief sought; and
