Dear Ms. Monahan:

This office has received your public records requests for the following documents:

“[1] All calendars or calendar entries for Attorney General Ashley Moody including any calendars maintained on Moody’s behalf. American Oversight requests that the calendars be produced in a format that includes all invitees, any notes, and all attachments. Please do not limit your search to Outlook calendars; we request the production of any calendar — paper or electronic, whether on government-issued or personal devices — used to track or coordinate how Moody allocates time on agency business. The search should include any calendars associated with Moody’s individual email accounts, as well as any official calendars maintained for her, including by their administrative assistants or schedulers. For part 1 of this request, please provide all responsive records from December 15, 2021 [sic] through the date a search is conducted.

[2] All records reflecting costs reimbursed or paid directly by your agency for any reimbursable expenses attributable to trips undertaken by Attorney General Moody. Responsive records include those reflecting any payments or reimbursements, associated with travel, lodging, the cost of government transportation, individual airfare, meals, rental vehicles, payments made via government-issued charge cards or travel cards, or other reimbursable expenses. To the extent your office has aggregated records sufficient to show all relevant expenses and costs, such as spreadsheets, American Oversight would accept production of such records as sufficient. To the extent your office does not have an aggregated record of these costs, American

Oversight requests records reflecting those costs, such as receipts, invoices, charge card or credit card statements, and reimbursement requests.”

With respect to request numbered one, this office has no responsive records. Please note that your request may include a typographical error.

With respect to request numbered two, your specific request will require an extensive use of agency personnel and time, as well as information technology resources, to retrieve and review the documents responsive to your request and ensure compliance with the exemptions under section 119.071, Florida Statutes, and applicable law. Therefore, a labor charge is being assessed pursuant to section 119.07(4)(d), Florida Statutes, for 2.0 hours of personnel time charged at an hourly rate of \$38.58 (\$77.16), and for .5 hours of personnel time charged at an hourly rate of \$20.23 (\$10.12), for a total labor charge of \$87.28.

Pursuant to Florida Public Records Act, section 119.07(4), Florida Statutes, please provide us with two checks: one in the amount of \$77.16, and one in the amount of \$10.12, both made payable to the **Department of Legal Affairs** and sent to my attention at the above-referenced address

Upon receipt of the aforementioned check, this office will begin to process and collect responsive records. This office will then forward to you the documents responsive to your request. It is estimated that the production of these records will take 2-7 days.

Please note that if this office does not receive a response within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, your specific request will be closed as non-responsive. Please do not hesitate to contact me in the event that you would like to discuss your current request, or if you would like to narrow it in any fashion.
