Dear Ms. Rasheed:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated October 27, 2021, in which you seek access to Postal Service records concerning:

- 1. Any conflicts or ethics waivers or authorizations, including authorizations pursuant to 5 C.F.R. § 2635.502, for Postmaster General DeJoy.*
- 2. Records reflecting any recusal determination made or issued for Postmaster General DeJoy.*
- 3. Records reflecting any ethics determinations or analysis of the application of ethics requirements to Postmaster General DeJoy.*
- 4. Records reflecting all expenses and costs incurred related to travel undertaken by Postmaster General DeJoy.*
- 5. All records reflecting any actual or projected expenditures for renovations (including remodeling or changes to décor) of any part of the office suites (including foyers, waiting rooms, conference rooms, adjacent hallways, or other common areas) for Postmaster General DeJoy.*

In response to number five (5) above; based on your description of records sought, a search was conducted of the files maintained by Vice President, Facilities. After a search was completed in our Facilities database, and a physical search of the Facilities files was conducted, eight (8) records were found.

We have redacted portions of the documents pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3) ("Exemption 3") and 39 U.S.C. § 410(c)(2) ("Section 410(c)(2)"). Exemption 3 allows withholding information that is "specifically exempted from disclosure by statute." Section 410(c)(2) qualifies as a statute that specifically exempts certain information from disclosure under Exemption 3. See *Wickwire Gavin v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, 356 F.3d 588, 592 n.6 (4th Cir. 2004); *Carlson v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, No. 13-cv-06017-JSC, 2015 WL 9258072, at *4 (N.D. Cal. Dec. 18, 2015); *Airline Pilots Ass'n v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, No. 03-2384 (ESH), 2004 WL 5050900, at *5 (D.D.C. June 24, 2004). Section 410(c)(2) also operates independently of the FOIA to exempt information from disclosure. Section 410(c)(2) provides that "information of a commercial nature, including trade secrets, whether or not obtained from a person outside the Postal Service, which under good business practice would not be publicly disclosed" is exempt from the disclosure requirements of the FOIA. Courts have broadly defined information of a commercial nature under Section 410(c)(2) to include all information that relates to commerce, trade, or profit. See *Carlson v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, 504 F.3d 1123, 1129 (9th Cir. 2007) (applying the "common meaning" of the term). So long as the information would not be disclosed "under good business practice," disclosure of the information need not result in competitive harm in order to qualify as exempt under Section 410(c)(2), nor must commercial interests outweigh the public interest in disclosure. See *Wickwire Gavin v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, 356 F.3d at 594-95.

We consider the disclosure of information relating to contracts such as, costs, rates, vendor name, order/invoice number, etc. to be contrary to good business practice, therefore the information is considered commercially sensitive, proprietary business information that the Postal Service does not disclose to the public and is therefore protected by FOIA Exemption 3 and U.S.C. § 410(c)(2).

We redacted other portions of the responsive documents pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6 (5 USC 552(b)(6)). Exemption 6 applies to personal information, including medical and personnel files, the disclosure of which would be a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Under Exemption 6, "personnel", "medical", and "similar" files are not limited to records or information containing only intimate details or highly personal information about an individual; rather, the exemption encompasses all records and information on an individual that can be identified as applying to that individual. See U.S. Dep't of State v. Wash. Post Co., 456 U.S. 595, 600-602 (1982). The personal privacy interests cognizable under Exemption 6 include an individual's interest in avoiding public disclosure of personal matters, see U.S. Dep't of Justice v. Reporters Comm. for Freedom of the Press, 489 U.S. 749, 762 (1989), which encompasses an individual's control of information concerning his or her person, see U.S. Dep't of Def. v. Fed. Labor Relations Auth., 510 U.S. 487, 500 (1994). Therefore, the records and information protected from public disclosure by Exemption 6 are not limited to those of an intimate or highly personal nature, see U.S. Dep't of State v. Washington Post Co., 456 U.S. 595, 600, 601, 602 (1982), but also include, for example, records and information the public disclosure of which could result in an adverse effect, such as annoyance, see Fed. Labor Relations Auth., 510 U.S. at 501. In order for a personal privacy interest to be cognizable under Exemption 6, its degree need only be very slight. See Fed. Labor Relations Auth., 510 U.S. at 500.

Therefore, records that relate to signatures, phone numbers and email addresses of individuals are "files" within the meaning of the exemption. If the Postal Service identifies an individual's cognizable personal privacy interest under Exemption 6 in the responsive record or information, it is then the requester's burden to overcome that personal privacy interest by establishing the following: (1) the requester seeks to advance a public interest cognizable under Exemption 6, and (2) the record or information is likely to advance that public interest; otherwise, the invasion of personal privacy is clearly unwarranted. See Nat'l Archives & Records Admin. v. Favish, 541 U.S. 157, 172 (2004). In determining whether to release records that may be protected by Exemption 6, the Postal Service must balance the privacy interests of the individuals involved against the public interest, if any, that would be served by disclosure. For FOIA Exemption 6, the only public interest to be weighed is the extent to which disclosure would serve the "core purpose" of the FOIA, which is to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government, or, in other words, to shed light on the conduct of government agencies. Your request did not meet the burden and we do not find a public interest in the disclosure of the redacted information.

If you are not satisfied with the response to this request, you may file an administrative appeal within 90 days of the date of this response letter by writing to the General Counsel U.S. Postal Service 475 L'Enfant Plaza SW Washington, DC 20260 or via email at FOIAAppeal@usps.gov. Your appeal must be postmarked or electronically transmitted within 90 days of the date of the response to your request. The letter of appeal should include, as applicable:

- (1) A copy of the request, of any notification of denial or other action, and of any other related correspondence;
- (2) The FOIA tracking number assigned to the request;
- (3) A statement of the action, or failure to act, from which the appeal is taken;
- (4) A statement identifying the specific redactions to responsive records that the requester is challenging;
- (5) A statement of the relief sought; and
- (6) A statement of the reasons why the requester believes the action or failure to act is erroneous.

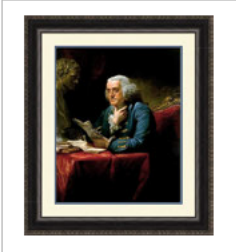
