Dear Mr. Slabinski:

On behalf of American Beverage Licensees (ABL), I am writing to express our strong opposition to the "[Statement of Principles on Direct-To-Consumer Shipping of Spirits](#)" and urge members of the American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC) to vote against the proposal during their upcoming meetings.

ABL represents independent beer, wine and spirits retailers who responsibly sell and serve alcohol in bars and package liquor stores throughout the country. ABL joins other national trade associations in the alcohol industry in opposition to efforts spearheaded by large liquor companies to advance an agenda of corporate enrichment by moving sales and revenue from locally-owned small businesses to their own coffers. Their support of these principles is aided by smaller liquor suppliers who unfortunately support this scheme despite their need for robust local brick-and-mortar retail support to build their brands.

If adopted, these principles will ultimately lead to:

- Fewer choices for average beverage alcohol consumers;
- The dangerous diminishment of the priority of public safety that has been a bedrock of sound alcohol regulatory policy since the repeal of Prohibition;
- Disregard for states' need to track and monitor incoming alcohol shipments for tax and regulatory purposes; and
- The growth of an already problematic dark market for alcohol shipping in the U.S. that threatens consumers and families with the specter of counterfeit and poisoned alcohol products.

Before we look at these potential outcomes, we want to underscore that beverage alcohol retailers understand the need for competition and compete every day with fellow retailers. They compete, however, on a level playing field in which competitors are playing by the same set of rules as other similarly licensed businesses.

Direct-to-Consumer supplier shipping of liquor upends that playing field, throwing dissimilarly licensed operators into the same pool, and giving liquor companies the upper hand to either sell products at a lower price because those products have not gone through the otherwise required alcohol regulatory system; or to sell them for the going retail price and take a significantly larger profit margin than traditional retailers.

Fewer choices for average beverage alcohol consumers

Beverage retailers are at the forefront of fostering trends, promoting innovative products, and meeting the everchanging needs of customers. DTC supplier liquor shipping would fragment this successful market for consumers. Under these principles, it is reasonable to expect that beverage retailers – and the majority of their customers – would never see a bottle of rare bourbon on a store shelf ever again as suppliers would keep these products for their own online sales, a practice already somewhat in effect with on-site distillery sales. Liquor companies would still expect retailers to sell their stable of mainstream brands, but not the exciting and new products that can drive customer traffic to local beverage businesses. Unless a customer wants to go online to pay non-competitive market prices because the only retail source of product is a single supplier, they are out of luck.

Direct-to-Consumer supplier liquor shipping would also have the long-term effect of shuttering small beverage retailers and thus providing less market access for up-and-coming distillers and their products. These small distillers, most of whom do not have the resources for massive marketing or online sales campaigns, rely on local retail sales, as well as wholesale market support, to grow and thrive. With more than 2,000 distillers in the U.S. today, the current model is working for these businesses. Undercutting these local entrepreneurs by allowing large liquor companies to dominate consumers with online sales is counterintuitive to small supplier interests and ultimately bad for the industry and consumers.

The dangerous diminishment of the priority of public safety that has been a bedrock of sound alcohol regulatory policy since the repeal of Prohibition

These principles place profits over public safety by casting sound alcohol regulatory policy aside under the false premise of meeting consumer needs. While beverage retailers proudly sell and serve beer, wine and spirits, most states treat retail liquor sales and licensing differently than those of beer and wine on the grounds of public safety. It is not inappropriate to recognize that liquor is treated differently by states and regulators and has been since Prohibition ended. In practical terms, this is born out in who may hold retail liquor licenses; how many retail liquor licenses may be held by an individual; liquor tax rates; and locations and times where and when liquor can be sold. And unlike wine and beer, where home brewing and winemaking at legal, “home distilling” is dangerous and rightly illegal.

Longstanding state policies on how liquor is treated are supported by legislators, regulators, public health and safety officials, licensed beverage retailers, alcohol wholesalers, alcohol suppliers and the public. It is also worth noting that these distinctions have not impeded the significant growth of the liquor industry, which has seen [supplier gross revenues soar from \\$18.2 billion in 2007 to \\$31.2 billion in 2020.](#)

There is also understanding within the alcohol industry that liquor is different than other alcohol products like beer. Recently, the Brewers Association, which represents small U.S.-based craft brewers, issued a statement ([“The Difference Between Beer and Liquor Statement”](#)) to that effect.

The recognition that beer and liquor are fundamentally different beverages, necessitating distinct regulatory treatment, is a core tenet of alcohol regulation in the United States. Reflecting beer’s status as the beverage of moderation and its contributions to the economy, it has historically and correctly been subject to lower excise tax rates and less stringent distribution restrictions than liquor.

While recognizing that changes in society or technology sometimes merit changes in the law, nothing has altered the important differences between beer and liquor. Liquor companies have thrived in the current tax and regulatory environment, so the BA sees no need to change long-standing and successful policies merely to enhance the profitability of those companies. We accordingly support distinct beer and liquor excise tax rates and oppose efforts to treat liquor as if it were beer.

Disregard for states’ need to track and monitor incoming alcohol shipments for tax and regulatory purposes

It is clear that these principles do not take into account the current broken state of interstate alcohol shipping. Supporters of these principles will argue that states already allow wine to be shipped directly from wineries. But what they fail to mention, and despite honest efforts by companies like FedEx and UPS, is that today most states have little control over alcohol being shipped illegally into their states. In Michigan, for example, [nearly one-third of every bottle of alcohol shipped into Michigan in 2019 was shipped illegally](#). In total, 2,233,880 bottles of alcohol were shipped into that state in 2019. Of those bottles, 734,365 were shipped illegally. This is just one state. Unless or until states have a better handle on how to track and regulate alcohol shipping, a vast expansion of the alcohol shipping marketplace – especially with no meaningful increase in state alcohol enforcement resources – is highly irresponsible.

Two states – Michigan and Ohio – have been compelled in the last 24 months to invoke the federal 21st Amendment Enforcement Act to thwart illegal alcohol shipping into their states. State attorney generals have issued hundreds, if not thousands, of cease-and-desist letters to suppliers, retailers and more frequently shadowy fulfillment companies that operate on the fringes of the market. These fulfillment houses are outside of the licensed system but very much responsible for whether or not beverage alcohol is illegally shipped to a state.

Efforts to remove any limits on the amount of alcohol that can be shipped directly by suppliers to entities in a state is a recipe for providing unscrupulous or unlicensed retailers with the ability to obtain and sell alcohol without going through the legal distribution system and acquiring the product from a licensed in-state wholesaler.

In addition to the current broken regulatory system for interstate DTC shipping, adopting or applying a single standard across states is immensely difficult if not impossible. Since 2019, ABL has participated with another group of well-intended state legislative leaders – the Uniform Law Commission (ULC) – on the issue of direct alcohol shipping compliance. Their ongoing effort illustrates the challenge of building out “model” alcohol laws given the fact that there are 50 distinct alcohol markets. After initially considering a broad scope that would create model shipping language, the ULC narrowed its focus to compliance and enforcement of direct-to-consumer winery shipping because 1) this is clearly an area where legislative guidance is needed; and 2) to do anything more prescriptive would not come close to achieving consensus support from within the alcohol industry.

The growth of an already problematic dark market for alcohol shipping in the U.S. that threatens consumers and families with the specter of counterfeit and poisoned alcohol products

Casting aside safeguards against counterfeit and poisoned alcohol products puts consumers and families at risk. While we have highlighted the problematic commercial and regulatory consequences that come with the push for liquor companies to directly ship alcohol, there is a societal and public health cost as well. Introducing thousands of new points of sale of liquor to the American public opens the doors wide for counterfeiters – already tinkering online and on social media platforms – to dupe regular consumers into purchasing adulterated, fake and/or illegal products. Current regulations for liquor sales successfully ensure product integrity, as evidenced by the absence of tainted or counterfeit alcohol in traditional retail sales channels. Unfortunately, it is all too common to see tragic headlines stemming from counterfeit alcohol in other countries with less stringent alcohol regulatory systems.

Accounts also abound of unmarked boxes of liquor bottles being shipped into states and delivered to doorsteps with no signature requested or required. Not necessarily the fault of the courier who may be delivering a regularly marked package, the limited enforcement of shipping laws and lack of consequences for illegal shippers makes bottles of liquor more likely to end up in the hands of kids should these principles be approved.

In closing, we want to remind those voting that these principles are neither in the Federalist tradition nor in keeping with the independence and unique identity of each of the states. These principles are highly divisive within the alcohol industry as they would shift power and profits away from local small business owners to publicly traded foreign corporations. These principles will lead to less overall consumer choice and imperil consumers by opening a currently reliable marketplace of safe and genuine products to a raft of fake and counterfeit products that would pose a severe threat to public health.



This effort is being foisted on ALEC by interests representing one sector of one tier of a diverse and expansive industry that best serves all interests when it evolves deliberately and after thoughtful discourse.

We appreciate the opportunity to comment on this important matter and would be happy to serve as a resource moving forward.

The Beer Institute, a national trade association representing U.S. beer brewers, beer importers, and suppliers to the industry, appreciates the opportunity to comment on the "Statement of Principles on Direct-to-Consumer Shipping of Spirits," scheduled for debate on Friday, July 30, 2021, in the ALEC Task Force process.

We believe the proposal needs extensive debate as it implicates a change to the three-tier system in place in the United States for many years. This debate should continue in the task force process. We do not recommend approval of the proposal soon or in its current form.

Mere distiller interest in expanded market opportunities does not warrant this sort of broad carve-out from the three-tier system. Distributors only source from licensed producers and importers and only sell to licensed retailers. This system guarantees not only proper tax collection but also that sales comply with state and local laws.

Moreover, alcohol is not all equal. Beer's average alcohol-by-volume (ABV) is a low 4.6%, while the ABV of most spirits approaches 40% or more. Beer is sold and consumed in various venues not available to spirits as policymakers for generations have determined that spirits products present particular concerns compared to wine and, indeed, compared to beer. Finally, putting these products in the stream of commerce through direct shipment doesn't account for the inability to track them to ensure that they reach the intended consumer. That creates a public safety concern not adequately addressed in the proposal.

We believe the proposal is a poorly disguised attempt by the distilled spirits industry to gain advantages for itself at the expense of state interests in controlling the sale of and access to alcohol by its citizenry.

Standard Speaker Guidelines Regarding Political Activity

Council for National Policy (CNP) is exempt from federal income tax under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. As such, it cannot “participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.” This restriction applies only to election campaigns, and does not apply to lobbying activities regarding legislation or ballot initiatives or referendums (in which the public is the legislature).

CNP Action, Inc. is exempt from federal income tax under §501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code. As such, it may engage in political activity to some extent, but such activity may not be its primary activity. However, under federal and state election laws, both CNP and CNP Action, Inc. are prohibited from making direct or in-kind contributions to federal and some state candidates. Both are subject to limits on the extent to which they may refer to candidates (even in discussions of public policy issues) during certain pre-election periods.

To help CNP and CNP Action, Inc. ensure that they comply with the requirements of §501(c)(3) and §501(c)(4), respectively, and with federal and state election laws, without compromising their message, CNP and CNP Action, Inc. respectfully request that you observe the following guidelines regarding political activity when you participate in any activity sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc.

Speakers: In any public presentation at an event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc., please do not endorse or denigrate any candidate for public office, or any political party, and do not use legislative issues in order to comment on, otherwise attempt to affect, any election.

Candidates: If you are a candidate for elective public office, please avoid any mention of your candidacy, or any impending election. Please do not conduct any fundraising or distribute any campaign literature on CNP’s premises or at any event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc., and do not otherwise use CNP’s resources, *e.g.*, office equipment and supplies, for your campaign.

Officeholders: In some cases, CNP and CNP Action, Inc. invites public officials to speak at or attend an event because of the office you hold in federal, state, or local government, and not because you are or may be a candidate for re-election, or for election to another public office. At such events, please do not engage in campaign activity, or otherwise suggest that your presence indicates endorsement, or opposition to your opponent (if any), by CNP and CNP Action, Inc.

Others: Please do not distribute campaign literature, conduct fundraising activities, or otherwise engage in political activity immediately before, during, or immediately after any event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc.

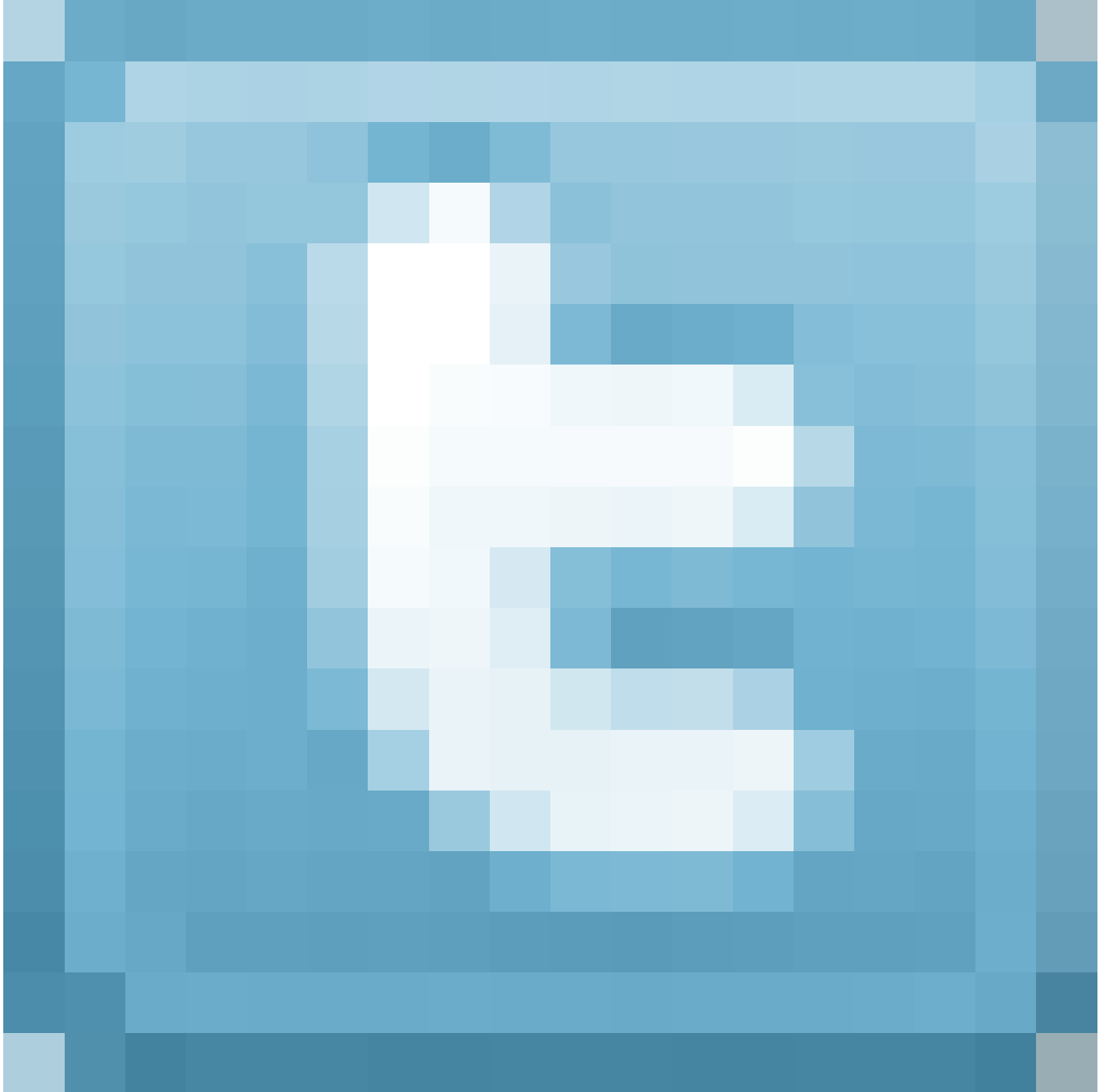

While some have been quick to demonize voter ID laws, the American people see voter ID requirements as easy, commonsense rules that protect their vote.

- Over three-quarters (77%) of Americans support photo ID requirements according to a poll commissioned by Honest Elections Project Action (HEP Action).
- A poll by Rasmussen found that 75% of likely voters say ID laws are necessary to a “fair and secure election process,” including 65% of Democrats and 70% of Moderates.
- 85% of Americans say voter ID requirements are “common sense,” according to a FreedomWorks/Scott Rasmussen poll.
- 72% of the public say photo ID requirements increase their confidence in our elections according to the FreedomWorks/Scott Rasmussen poll.

COUNCIL FOR NATIONAL POLICY

Standard Speaker Guidelines Regarding Political Activity

Council for National Policy (CNP) is exempt from federal income tax under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. As such, it cannot “participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.” This restriction applies only to election campaigns, and does not apply to lobbying activities regarding legislation or ballot initiatives or referendums (in which the public is the legislature).



CNP Action, Inc. is exempt from federal income tax under §501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code. As such, it may engage in political activity to some extent, but such activity may not be its primary activity. However, under federal and state election laws, both CNP and CNP Action, Inc. are prohibited from making direct or in-kind contributions to federal and some state candidates. Both are subject to limits on the extent to which they may refer to candidates (even in discussions of public policy issues) during certain pre-election periods.

To help CNP and CNP Action, Inc. ensure that they comply with the requirements of §501(c)(3) and §501(c)(4), respectively, and with federal and state election laws, without compromising their message, CNP and CNP Action, Inc. respectfully request that you observe the following guidelines regarding political activity when you participate in any activity sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc.

Speakers: In any public presentation at an event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc., please do not endorse or denigrate any candidate for public office, or any political party, and do not use legislative issues in order to comment on, otherwise attempt to affect, any election.

Candidates: If you are a candidate for elective public office, please avoid any mention of your candidacy, or any impending election. Please do not conduct any fundraising or distribute any campaign literature on CNP’s premises or at any event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc., and do not otherwise use CNP’s resources, e.g., office equipment and supplies, for your campaign.

Officeholders: In some cases, CNP and CNP Action, Inc. invites public officials to speak at or attend an event because of the office you hold in federal, state, or local government, and not because you are or may be a candidate for re-election, or for election to another public office. At such events, please do not engage in campaign activity, or otherwise suggest that your presence indicates endorsement, or opposition to your opponent (if any), by CNP and CNP Action, Inc.

Others: Please do not distribute campaign literature, conduct fundraising activities, or otherwise engage in political activity immediately before, during, or immediately after any event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc.

Thank you for your consideration. Your participation in any event sponsored by CNP and CNP Action, Inc. indicates that you have agreed to observe these guidelines. If you have any questions about the meaning or application of these guidelines, please contact CNP staff at (202) 207-0165.
