- No ballot harvesting - violators will be punished to full extent of the law
- Voter ID a must, may consider fingerprint id or face recognition
- Cameras installed every polling locations so everything can be observed
- Chain of custody documentation from beginning to end
- Vote by mail only accepted by approved circumstances, must provide proof of verification, must be sent certified.
- Poll watchers and workers should be assigned to different districts to avoid conflicts and to eliminate fraud by group
- Hire trustworthy and vetted people as Election Administrators (need an investigation of current ones)
- Must be checks and balances in every situation

I want my vote to be treated my banking account, my bank has measures in place to ensure by my deposits, withdrawals etc. are handled to ensure it is accuracy. If a mistake is discovered let's say I deposited \$1,000 but the bank only credited me \$400, I think this would cause alarm. I wouldn't just say oh there is always a few mistakes with deposits so I'll just let it go. No I would request they correct the deposit and credit the full \$1,000. Why aren't our elections handled in this matter. Why is any fraud acceptable? This thinking must be stopped! Our elections need to be 100% correct and verifiable! Also would you hire a theft to work in your bank? Would you bank allow you to make a transaction without ID? Don't you feel comfortable knowing your bank has cameras in case an incident happens and they need to verify what actually happened. Our elections should be run like a bank...no room for error and if error happens correct it immediately.

Thank you for your time and I would appreciate a return e-mail to let me know what is being done currently on election integrity. We must have a free and fair elections and sadly I'm beginning to believe that we may have never had.
