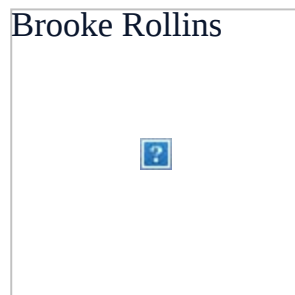

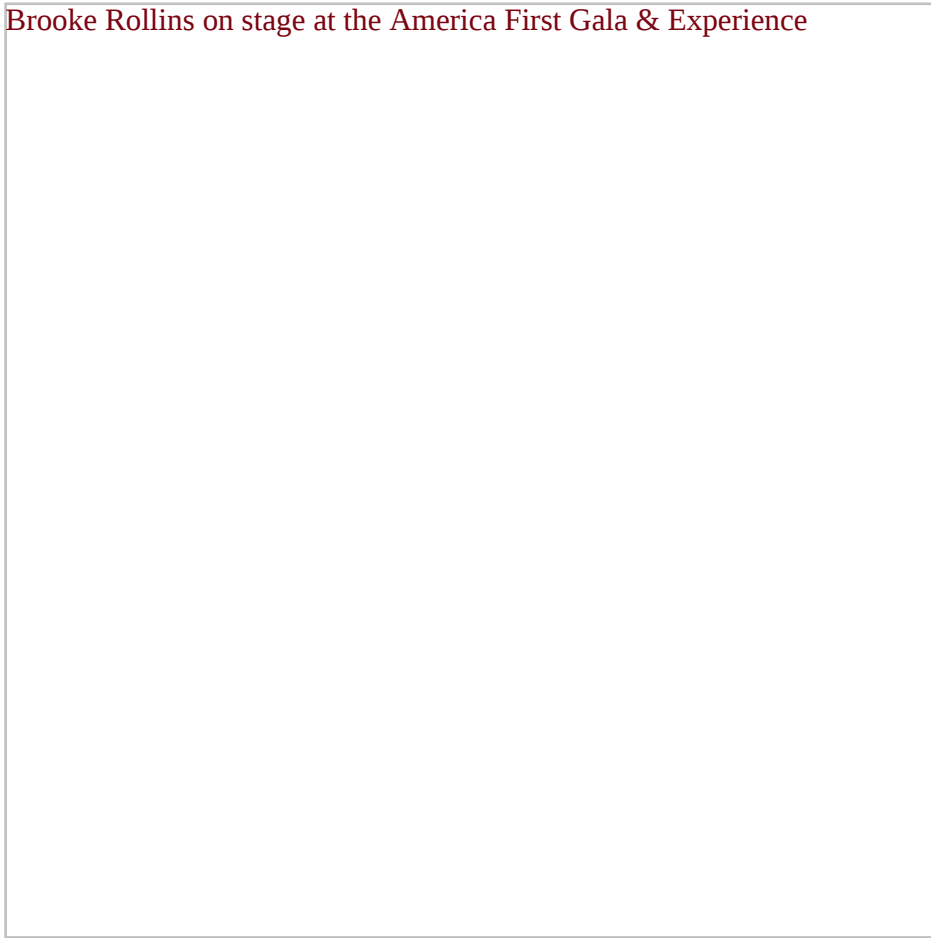

Polling Update

Here at AFPI, we are tracking the pulse of the American people.

According to a **poll** from Monmouth University, two-thirds of Americans say their Thanksgiving Day gathering will return to pre-Covid levels this year, after half of the country said they planned to spend the holiday alone or with their immediate household last year.

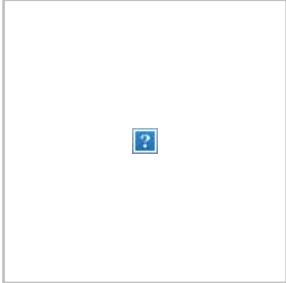
