Dear Taylor,

This is 1 of 2 emails to fulfill the 6 requests originally made December 1, 2021 regarding Sen. Manzella, Rep. Tschida, and Rep. Phalen: Public Records Request MT-REP-21-1720 and 1724, 1719 and 1723, 1718 and 1722.

For each request for each legislator, each of the 26 searches is listed in a separate folder. The criteria for each search is stored in the respective folder in a text file named "PIR# – SEARCH NAME – search criteria.txt".

The request was for "All email communications ... between [legislator] and each of the email addresses or domains listed". Because the requestor included the email addresses of the 26 listed entities these results have returned any email message in each legislator's account w/ the respective email address in either the To: or the From: field.

The search process does not require that the legislator has to be the originator or the sole recipient of an email message to match the criteria, only that the email address in the criteria is found in the either the To: or From: field. There may be messages that were sent from another sender to both the legislator and the email address in the respective search criteria – that message will be returned as a match for the criteria.

If there were no matches found for a particular search that result is noted in a "PIR# - [legislator] – SEARCH NAME – no results.txt" for the respective search.

Dear Ms Kubat and Arizona State Senator Townsend.

I appreciate the opportunity to help make this bill effective and end the stranglehold of big tech on Free Speech. There is a bill that has been well refined and well researched with experts in 7 states and and meets the legal standards set forth in Federal Law. It is not in conflict with Federal Law which of course would render any State Law void and unenforceable.

Please see the attached PDF with **Rev C refinements which just came out today (shrunk to 2 Pages)**. I suggest doing a striker amendment. Here is why.

- 1) It is important to fully review and understand the Federal Law, Sect 230 before crafting effective and viable State statute. <https://www.law.cornell.edu/uscode/text/47/230>
- 2) The definitions in Sect 230 are different than any state Statute which is written from scratch. The PDF version uses the exact same definitions from Sect 230 cut and paste, word for word. Any defense lawyer will successfully argue that a State Statute is defective because the definitions are different and it is thus not in keeping with Sect 230 which is required. Sect 230 definitions are close enough so we use them "EXACTLY" and thus defeat that argument. See Sect (1) of the PDF.
- 3) For some reason most State bills provide for damages and punitive damages which are expressly prohibited by Sect 230 so these bills are DOA and completely ineffective. THE GOOD NEWS is we don't need any damages because that is not what we are seeking anyway. **We want our free speech rights restored and to put an end to censorship.** THIS is the reason you are reading this email.

4) Sections (2) thru (6) are the means of applying Due Process in keeping with Sect 230 and the US and State Constitutions in the least "Burdensome" manner we can devise per Federalist 83 Paragraph 16 (87%). Reasonable costs and fees for the prevailing party are almost always available in civil actions and are NOT prohibited by Sect 230.

5) The last provision "Residency" is included as an optional feature that might greatly expand the reach, effectiveness, and potential revenue derived from this Bill. It is presented as a separate Statute so if it were to be challenged it would not impede the function of the remaining law which is thought to be unassailable and **"bullet proof"**. We follow all directives of Sect 230 while still eliminating censorship. We love Section 230 so much, we made it part of our State Statute and merely expanded on it and made Sect 230 even better.

Again, I appreciate the opportunity to help our Legislature serve the People of Arizona and I am at the service of Senator Townsend entirely at her convenience. I am becoming adept at explaining this bill to legislators in various States and can do so in 10 or 15 minutes by phone or in person at your discretion. **There is a lot of pent up enthusiasm for supporting FREEDOM of SPEECH.**
