Dear Danny Martinez:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act request dated and received in this Office on April 20, 2026 seeking all electronic communications between various Department officials and @Epstein.co or @btitopllc.com, since January 20, 2025. **Please note that this Office was closed due to a lapse in funding appropriations from October 1, 2025 through November 12, 2025, which has resulted in a delay in responding to your request.**

A proper Freedom of Information Act request for records must reasonably describe the records sought. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(3)(A); see also 28 C.F.R. § 16.3(b)(2022). After carefully reviewing your request, I have determined that you did not reasonably describe the subject of your request in a manner which allows agency personnel to locate the requested records with a reasonable amount of effort. Your request is seeking all email and text messages between at least six of the Department's highest ranking officials and two email domains with no topic for a seventeen month period of time. Accordingly, in the absence of a more specific topic for your request and/or a more limited timeframe, your request is not reasonably described as required by the FOIA. If you would like to discuss reformulation of your request, you may contact this Office.

If you submit your appeal by mail, both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
