Re: Public Records Request

Dear Public Records Officer:

Pursuant to the Arizona Public Records Law, A.R.S. §§ 39-121 et seq., American Oversight makes the following request for records.

Requested Records

American Oversight requests that the Arizona Department of Economic Security promptly produce the following records:

All email communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, calendar invitations, and calendar invitation attachments) between (a) any of the officials listed below, and (b) any of the external individuals and entities also listed below (including, but not limited to, anyone communicating from an email address ending in the listed domains), and (c) containing any of the key terms listed below.

Department of Economic Security Officials:

- a. Michael Wisheart, Director
- b. Anyone serving in the capacity of Deputy Director, Assistant Director, or equivalent
- c. Anyone serving in the capacity of Chief of Staff, or equivalent, to the Director
- d. Anyone serving in the capacity of Director, Manager, or equivalent, Nutrition Assistance

External Individuals and Entities:

- i. Anyone communicating on behalf of the White House, including, but not limited to, anyone using an email address that contains "who.eop.gov" or "whitehouse.gov"



- ii. Anyone communicating on behalf of the U.S. House of Representatives, including, but not limited to, anyone using an email address that contains “house.gov”
- iii. Anyone communicating on behalf of the U.S. Senate, including, but not limited to, anyone using an email address that contains “senate.gov”
- iv. Katie Hobbs, Governor of Arizona
- v. Chad Campbell, Chief of Staff, Office of the Governor of Arizona
- vi. Anyone communicating on behalf of the Office of the Governor of Arizona, including, but not limited to, anyone communicating by using an email address that contains “azgovernor.gov”
- vii. Anyone communicating on behalf of the Arizona State Legislature, including, but not limited to, anyone communicating by using an email address that contains “azleg.gov”
- viii. Anyone communicating on behalf of the Arizona State Legislature, including, but not limited to, anyone communicating by using an email address that contains “azhouse.gov”

Please note that American Oversight does not seek, and that this request specifically excludes, the initial mailing of news clips or other mass-distribution emails. However, subsequent communications responding to or forwarding such emails are responsive to this request. For example, if a specific individual received a mass-distribution news clip email containing the term from the White House, that initial email would not be responsive to this request. However, if that specific individual forwarded that email to another individual with their own commentary, that subsequent message would be responsive to this request and should be produced.

Please provide all responsive records from January 1, 2026, through the date the search is conducted.

Statement of Noncommercial Purpose

This request is made for noncommercial purposes. American Oversight seeks records regarding federal policy impacts on hunger in Arizona.¹ Records with the potential to shed light on this issue would contribute significantly to public understanding of operations of the government, including to what extent federal policy has exacerbated hunger in Arizona.

Because American Oversight is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, this request is not in American Oversight's financial interest and is not made for a commercial purpose. American Oversight's mission is to promote transparency in government, to educate the public about government activities, and to ensure the accountability of government officials. American Oversight uses the information gathered, and its analysis of it, to educate the public through reports, press releases, or other media. American Oversight also makes materials it gathers available on its public website and promotes their availability on social media platforms, such as Facebook and X (formerly Twitter).²

Because this request is made for noncommercial purposes, American Oversight requests that any fees charged in connection with processing this request be limited to copying and postage charges, if applicable.³ Please notify American Oversight of any anticipated fees or costs in excess of \$100 prior to incurring such costs or fees.

Guidance Regarding the Search & Processing of Requested Records

In connection with its request for records, American Oversight provides the following guidance regarding the scope of the records sought and the search and processing of records:

- Please search all locations and systems likely to have responsive records, regardless of format, medium, or physical characteristics. For instance, if the request seeks "communications," please search all locations likely to contain communications, including relevant hard-copy files, correspondence files, appropriate locations on hard drives and shared drives, emails, text messages or other direct messaging systems (such as iMessage, WhatsApp, Signal, or X

(formerly Twitter) direct messages), voicemail messages, instant messaging systems such as Lync or ICQ, and shared messages systems such as Slack.

- In conducting your search, please understand the terms “record,” “document,” and “information” in their broadest sense, to include any written, typed, recorded, graphic, printed, or audio material of any kind.
- Our request for records includes any attachments to those records or other materials enclosed with those records when they were previously transmitted. To the extent that an email is responsive to our request, our request includes all prior messages sent or received in that email chain, as well as any attachments to the email.
- Please search all relevant records or systems containing records regarding agency business. Do not exclude records regarding agency business contained in files, email accounts, or devices in the personal custody of your officials, such as personal email accounts or text messages.
- If any records are withheld in full or in part, pursuant to A.R.S. § 39-121.01(D)(2), please provide an index of records or categories of records that have been withheld and the reasons the records or categories of records have been withheld.
- In the event some portions of the requested records are properly exempt from disclosure, please disclose any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of the requested records. If a request is denied in whole, please state specifically why it is not reasonable to segregate portions of the record for release.
- Please take appropriate steps to ensure that records responsive to this request are not deleted by the agency before the completion of processing for this request. If records potentially responsive to this request are likely to be located on systems where they are subject to potential deletion, including on a scheduled basis, please take steps to prevent that deletion, including, as appropriate, by instituting a litigation hold on those records.

If you have any questions regarding how to construe this request for records or believe that further discussions regarding search and processing would facilitate a more efficient production of records of interest to American Oversight, please do not hesitate to contact American Oversight to discuss this request.
