This is in response to the above referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests. Specifically, this is a supplemental release of the Form 586 After-Action Review Reports, which were previously released to you on March 3, 2020.

Staff reviewed 24 pages of responsive records, which were forwarded to this office for a release determination. After careful review, we determined 24 pages are appropriate for release in part. Copies of releasable records are attached.

Explanation of FOIA Exemptions Used by the Federal Bureau of Prisons
