This letter is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), dated May 29, 2019. You have requested all email communications with any of the following individuals/organizations, including messages where custodians or outside individuals/organizations were carbon copied or blind carbon copied. This request includes all prior messages (whether incoming or outgoing) reflected in any responsive emails and any attachments to any responsive emails.

- a. Federation for American Immigration Reform (including any emails sent to or received from an address ending in @fairus.org)
- b. Immigration Reform Law Institute (including any emails sent to or received from an address ending in @irli.org)

- e. The Remembrance Project (including any emails sent to or received from an address ending in @theremembranceproject.org)

ICE has considered your request under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552. A search of the ICE Office of Director and the ICE Office of Information, Governance and Privacy for records responsive to your request produced 77 pages that are responsive to your request. After review of those documents, I have determined that portions of the pages will be withheld pursuant to Exemptions of the FOIA as described below.

ICE has applied Exemption 5 to protect from disclosure intra-agency documents that contain the recommendations, opinions, and conclusions of agency employees. The disclosure of these communications would discourage the expression of candid opinions and inhibit the free and frank exchange of information and opinions among agency personnel on important agency decision-making by having a chilling effect on the agency's deliberative process.

FOIA Exemption 5 protects from disclosure those inter- or intra-agency documents that are normally privileged in the civil discovery context. The three most frequently invoked privileges are the deliberative process privilege, the attorney work-product privilege, and the attorney-client privilege. After carefully reviewing the responsive documents, I have determined that portions of the responsive documents qualify for protection under the deliberative process privilege. The deliberative process privilege protects the integrity of the deliberative or decision-making processes within the agency by exempting from mandatory disclosure opinions, conclusions, and recommendations included within inter-agency or intra-agency memoranda or letters. The release of this internal information would discourage the expression of candid opinions and inhibit the free and frank exchange of information among agency personnel.

ICE has applied FOIA Exemptions 6 and 7(C) to protect from disclosure the names, e-mail addresses, and phone numbers of DHS employees contained within the documents.

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. The privacy interests of the individuals in the records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.

FOIA Exemption 7(C) protects records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes that could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This exemption takes particular note of the strong interests of individuals, whether they are suspects, witnesses, or investigators, in not being unwarrantably associated with alleged criminal activity. That interest extends to persons who are not only the subjects of the investigation, but those who may have their privacy invaded by having their identities and information about them revealed in connection with an investigation. Based upon the traditional recognition of strong privacy interest in law enforcement records, categorical withholding of information that identifies third parties in law enforcement records is ordinarily appropriate. As such, I have determined that the privacy interest in the identities of individuals in the records you have requested clearly outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Please

note that any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into this determination.

ICE has applied FOIA Exemption 7(E) to protect from disclosure internal agency case numbers, secured URL's and law enforcement sensitive information contained within the document.

FOIA Exemption 7(E) protects records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would disclose techniques and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law. I have determined that disclosure of certain law enforcement sensitive information contained within the responsive records could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law. Additionally, the techniques and procedures at issue are not well known to the public.

You have a right to appeal the above withholding determination. Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 90 days of the date of this letter following the procedures outlined in the DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5 § 5.8. You may submit your appeal electronically at GILDFOIAAppeals@ice.dhs.gov or via regular mail to:

Mr. Blank –

Here's a vivid example from today: A group called SIREN is quoted in the *Washington Post* as referring to the Oakland enforcement efforts as "ICE attacks"

Maricela Gutiérrez, executive director of the immigrant-advocacy organization SIREN, said that at first reactions within the immigrant community were mixed after Schaaf announced the raid. There had been panic, she said, and a lot of questions: How did the mayor get this information? How does she know it's really going to happen?

Still, Gutierrez said, she and her colleagues took the opportunity to alert the community and provide resources about their legal rights if they were confronted by ICE.

"It really created a mass mobilization," she said. "As advocates, we took [Schaaf's warning] very seriously. When do you hear a mayor of a big city announcing that an ICE attack is going to happen? Never. If she's saying that, it must be true."

This is the fallout of the government amnestying 3 million illegal aliens in 1986 which spawned a number of advocacy groups who helped carry it out:

"Services, Immigrant Rights and Education Network (SIREN) began as an ad-hoc coalition of immigrant rights activists and advocates in 1987 under the name Network for Immigrant and Refugee Rights and Services (NIRRS) in order to develop a Santa Clara County response to the 1986 Immigration Reform and Control Act. For over a decade, the NIRRS was central to statewide campaigns against all the anti-immigration legislation and ballot initiatives that followed.

"In 1998, NIRRS changed its name to Services, Immigrant Rights and Education Network (SIREN) and received seed funding to hire staff and establish the county's first-ever multilingual information hotline. Since that time, SIREN has grown to include policy analysis and advocacy, community education, legal services, and community and service provider trainings." <http://www.siren-bayarea.org/about/>

In other words, one simple amnesty created groups that now work to undermine enforcement efforts. The Gang of Eight amnesty actually had a \$150 million slush fund specifically for advocacy groups that would presumably help carry out the amnesty. The bill's language included little direction on how the groups could spend it. And don't forget that the very advocates who helped write the Gang of Eight amnesty would benefit from the funds directly. And they'd use some of the taxpayer dollars as seed money for new open-border groups.

South and North Korea are gearing up to expand cross-border cooperation to various environment areas, such as nature, atmosphere and water, Seoul's top environment policymaker said Wednesday. Minister of Environment Kim Eun-kyung said that her ministry and other relevant government agencies are steadily preparing to expand cooperation with North Korea in all parts of the environment. "The environment sector, which is relevant to political, economic and military issues, will play an important role in the early stages of inter-Korean cooperation," Kim said in a speech to a forum held at the National Assembly. It's topics like the one in this blog post today that I'd like them to talk about:

Feds Provide Almost \$2 Billion in Subsidies to Hire Alien Grads Rather than U.S. Grads

The Optional Practical Training (OPT) program, in which the American government *pays* American employers to discriminate *against* American workers has grown rapidly in recent years, and during FY 2017 it used nearly \$2 billion swiped from trust funds for the elderly to favor 240,000 alien college grads over an equal number of U.S.-resident grads.

It is hard to believe, but true; employers of foreign students who have a decree from a U.S. institution are given an 8.25 percent tax break if they hire an alien, rather than a U.S. college grad with the same skills, and paid at the same salary, as we described in some detail in a [recent posting](#).

...

I took the 240,000, and applied a guess of \$50,000 a year for these jobs (it is probably rather higher for the STEM people) and multiplied to get a rough idea of the total wages. It comes to about \$12 billion.

Since employers and employees — routinely — each contributes 8.25 percent of the salary to the trust funds, this indicates a loss to the funds of 16.5 percent of the whole, or a total annual loss of \$1.98 billion.

So the government is giving almost \$2 billion in tax breaks to American employers if they hire alien — not resident workers.

I'll put together some questions they can think about in advance of the meeting.
