Dear Mr. Evers:

This is a response to your correspondence received on June 7, 2019, in which you requested information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA),¹ and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) FOIA regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 388.108 (2019). Specifically, you requested the following:

All records reflecting communications (including emails, email attachments, text messages, calendar invitations, calendar entries, meeting notices, meeting agendas and any handwritten or electronic notes taken during any oral communications) between (1) Chairman Neil Chatterjee and/or Deputy Director of External Affairs Lindsee Gentry and (2) Senator Mitch McConnell, any representative Senator McConnell, and/or any person working in Senator McConnell's office, including but not limited to any person communicating from an email address ending in @mcconnell.senate.gov or @teammitch.com.

An initial determination and associated responsive documents were provided to you on July 31, 2019. At this time, a search of the Commission's non-public files has identified 52 additional documents responsive to your request. The 52 documents, which are comprised of email communications, are released with personal contact information redacted pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6.²

Given the volume of information requested and the amount of Commission staff time required to process any additional responsive documents, an additional determination addressing any remaining documents will follow on a rolling basis. In this regard, we will endeavor to provide you with another determination within 20 business days of the date of this letter.³

Ordinarily, any appeal from a FOIA determination must be filed within 90 days of the date of issuance as provided by the Freedom of Information Act and 18 C.F.R. § 388.110(a)(1) of the Commission's regulations. However, because your request is being processed on a rolling basis, the Commission will hold your appeal rights in abeyance pending a final determination. This will allow you to file a single appeal at the conclusion of our processing of your request.

If you decide to appeal, this appeal must be in writing, addressed to David L. Morenoff, Acting General Counsel, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, NE, Washington, D.C. 20426, and clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." Please include a copy to Charles A. Beamon, Associate General Counsel, General and Administrative Law, at the same address.

You have the right to seek dispute resolution services from the FOIA Public Liaison of the agency or the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS). Using OGIS services does not affect your right to pursue your appeal. You may contact OGIS by mail at Office of Government Information Services, National Archives and Records

McConnell Announces Senior Staff Changes

Scott Raab Promoted to Policy Director, Scott Sloofman to be Staff Director of the Senate Republican Communications Center, and Jen Kuskowski rejoins the McConnell team as Policy Advisor

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-KY) today announced a promotion and two additions to his senior staff in the Majority Leader office.

Longtime McConnell Policy Advisor Scott Raab will be promoted to the Policy Director position at the beginning of the 116th Congress, replacing Hazen Marshall, who will depart the Leader's office at the end of this Congress. Former McConnell staffer Scott Sloofman will return to the Leader's office to serve as Staff Director for the Senate Republican Communications Center. Sloofman previously worked in the Senate Republican Communications Center as a Communications Advisor. Another former McConnell staffer, Jen Kuskowski, will join his Leader Office policy team as Policy Advisor, taking over Raab's policy portfolio, including health care, commerce, and telecommunications issues.

Since joining the McConnell team in 1999, Raab has played a key role in advancing numerous

McConnell legislative priorities. Before joining the Republican Leader office in 2010, he served as the Legislative Director in McConnell's personal office. A graduate of George Washington University, Raab also worked for the offices of Bill Brewster and Wes Watkins of Oklahoma.

"I have relied on Scott's sound counsel and policy expertise for two decades to deliver victories for Kentucky and our nation," McConnell said. "I look forward to his continued service as Policy Director to help shape and implement our Conference's policy agenda."

Most recently, Sloofman served as Communications Director for Governor Larry Hogan's (R-MD) re-election campaign. A graduate of American University, Sloofman also served as Research Director for Leader McConnell's most recent re-election campaign.

"I'm excited to welcome Scott Sloofman back to my team to serve in this important role. Senate Republicans have a great story to tell after delivering wins across the board for the American people," McConnell added.

Kuskowski currently serves as Health Policy Director to Chairman Orrin Hatch (R-UT) on the Senate Finance Committee and was previously a Senior Policy Advisor for the committee. Prior to joining the Finance Committee, she served as Legislative Director in McConnell's personal office and worked in the office of Mary Bono. A graduate of Franklin & Marshall College, Kuskowski also served in the Peace Corps in Ecuador.

"Jen has applied her legislative expertise to the benefit of Kentucky, our conference and the nation. I'm happy to have her back on my team in this important role," McConnell added.
