Dear Ms. Stoneman:

As noted in our letter dated December 28, 2022, we are processing your request for material under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The processing of records is completed and has yielded an additional eight records responsive to your request. Upon review, we have determined that one record may be release in full and seven records may be released in part.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made redactions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each record. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released and is enclosed.
