This is the final response letter to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of Personnel Management (OPM), dated July 17, 2019. Specifically, you requested the following information:

- “Records sufficient to identify any and all contracts between the following agencies and (a) the below-listed individuals who were nominated but not confirmed to serve in the listed agencies or (b) any legal entities operated by or on behalf of the listed individuals:

 - U.S. Office of Personnel Management
 - George Nesterchuk

“Please provide all responsive records reflecting contracts entered into from January 20, 2017, through the date of the search.”

We thoroughly searched all of our systems and our electronic contracting files and found no such contracts or records between the US Office of Personnel Management and George Nesterchuk.

You have the right to appeal this determination. Should you wish to do so, pursuant to 5 CFR 294.110, you must send a copy of your initial request, a copy of the letter denying the request, and a statement as to why you believe the denying official erred within 90 days from the date of this letter to:
