State FSA leader to ranchers: Have faith in Trump (Capital Press, Matthew Weaver, 6/8)

AIRWAY HEIGHTS, Wash. — The Washington state executive director of the USDA Farm Service Agency has a message for ranchers: Keep your faith in President Donald Trump.

“There just really is a heart for the people in rural America,” Brian Dangel told a Spokane County Cattlemen meeting June 6.

He cited Trump’s executive order promoting agriculture and rural prosperity in America, removing troublesome regulations and providing more “common sense and local control.”

“It’s really remarkable, I think, that the president, who comes from Manhattan and has never farmed or done any of that in his life, has a heart for it. He’s a good man for it,” Dangel said. “He doesn’t want to see the farmers and producers hurt, but he also knows you can’t throw the baby out with the bathwater on these trade deals.”

Dangel called trade a “damned if you do, damned if you don’t” situation.

“While we want access to markets, we have a little bit of a problem with the (Trans-Pacific Partnership) being a little too intrusive and onerous,” he said.

Dangel said he expects eventual trade pacts with individual countries, but doesn’t foresee any sort of plan like TPP.

“In agriculture, one of our biggest challenges in my opinion is that we have producers who are well-intentioned and come from the right spot, but maybe we get folks from wheat fighting with folks from the beef industry, and dairies are always getting bullied on by (the Environmental Protection Agency) and the Department of Ecology,” he said. “It’s hard to have a unified voice. That I think is what’s missing from today’s agriculture.”

Dangel said he’s heard from trade groups and agencies that they have faith that Trump and the USDA will be able to access markets.

“Donald Trump is a good man and I don’t think he’s going to abandon these folks,” he said. “Just bear with us. I think the good times are coming.”

Born in Republic, Wash., Dangel was a Ferry County commissioner and served on the Washington State Senate from 2013 to 2017. He was special assistant to Agriculture Secretary Sonny Perdue when Perdue came on board in January 2017, and took at the Farm Service Agency office in Spokane in November 2017.

Dangel praised Perdue as a worker who is first in to the office every morning, and last to leave.

“One of the things I saw that I never thought I would see from a Cabinet-level secretary, was him going around and literally asking even janitors, ‘How can I make your job better? What can I do?’” Dangel said. “He gives that level of detail to every single person that comes into the building.”

Programs that serve ranchers include the livestock indemnity program, to guard against loss of cows for weather events, natural disasters and unforeseen circumstances. Dansel said changes have been made to improve the program. An “absurd” rule under the Obama administration required three straight days of temperatures of 20 degrees below zero to qualify, he said.

Now, ranchers must provide a letter from their veterinarian to qualify, Dansel said.

“That’s what I think people have been looking for: A little bit more of a common-sense approach,” he said.

Dansel is working to get more access for ranchers to funds under the program.

Dansel also cautioned youths who use the FSA’s microloan program and their parents: Be sure to pay back the loan. If not, they might not be able to qualify for student loans or other federal benefits.

“We’ll work with you. ... We’re not here to be the bad guys,” he said. “But sometimes, and it’s just the way the world works. There are rules, and one of the rules is, you’ve got to pay back loans. We’re also trying to teach responsibility with lending and borrowing.”

Field Leadership Team,

As you know, the President has placed a huge emphasis on rural development as part of his core agenda to promote stronger businesses and agricultural economies. To support this focus, on April 4 of this year, while on a road trip in rural Ohio with U.S. Department of Agriculture Secretary Sonny Perdue, I had the privilege of signing a Memorandum of Understanding between our agencies.

The MOU seeks to bring the complementary strengths of SBA and USDA together and increase the outreach of our joint programs, leveraging the combined distribution capabilities of the two agencies. This concerted effort is also intended to strategically align investments to the priorities established by the President's Agriculture and Rural Prosperity Taskforce. USDA's and SBA's mutual interests include the following: improving access to lending for rural small businesses; increasing investment opportunities in rural areas; identifying ways to increase the benefits of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017; and providing more access to federal contracting programs to rural businesses.

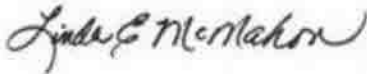
In the months since we signed the MOU, there has been an increased synergy between our two agencies and an unprecedented level of cooperation. Our Program Offices have been working with their counterparts in USDA to define the programs further in great detail. The key aspects of the programs, and a detailed action plan outlining the objectives and tasks that we will execute with USDA are highlighted below.

So, what is my request of you?

- a) Please familiarize yourself with these programs – if you have questions, please reach out to Richard Kingan (Richard.kingan@sba.gov) in the Office of Field Operations.
- b) Socialize the programs with your staff so that they have a full understanding of the joint programs.
- c) Reach out to the USDA Field Offices (I understand that some of you have already done that) and connect with the USDA Field Directors in your region. Richard Kingan will provide the USDA field contacts for your region. The USDA Field Teams are receiving a similar message and will be familiar with the MOU and the joint programs.
- d) Execute the joint programs in conjunction with USDA and the Program Offices.

This is a major undertaking that affects the lives of millions of hardworking Americans and I am proud of our team's efforts thus far. Thank you for your continued efforts.

Joint Programs

Lending

Introduce cross-selling programs leveraging the broad portfolio and distribution capabilities of both SBA and USDA.

- Create a product matrix that highlights the loan products offered by SBA and USDA as a single portfolio – and the target segments that are applicable (when to sell what?)
- Distribute joint product training matrix to field teams at USDA and SBA – SBA staff is pre-dominantly located in metropolitan areas while USDA staff is located across a broad geography including rural areas
- Create and distribute field contacts to both SBA and USDA teams so that the field teams can connect at the local level
- Schedule cross trainings of the field teams

- USDA to host Webinar for the SBA field office Lender Relation Specialists, District and Center Directors and their Deputies, OCA Microloan Staff and others on Tuesday, July 24, 2018 regarding the USDA Business and Loan Guaranty (B&L) program
- SBA
 - SBA is planning Webinars for the USDA rural business staff – dates to be announced shortly

Investments

Clarify Community Reinvestment Act (CRA) requirements to encourage investments into Small Business Investment Companies (SBICs) as well as Rural Business Investment Companies (RBICs).

- CRA cross-training event, scheduled for September 18, 2018 at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill
- Co-branded event with SBA, USDA, and bank regulators (FRB, OCC, and FDIC) to deliver a learning session focusing on banks seeking to invest or who have already invested in SBICs and/or RBICs. The event will help SBA and USDA to cross-market and elevate the SBIC/RBIC programs before the broad audience of current and prospective bank investors and investment fund managers

Modify the license application processes and procedures for SBICs/RBICs

- Make it easier for applicants to repurpose data when applying for either a SBIC or RBIC license

Contracting

Leverage the benefits of the qualified Opportunity Zones created by the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act and the HUBZones created by SBA to help small businesses in low-income communities to promote private investment while providing small businesses in rural areas with federal contracting opportunities. Also, explore opportunities to overlay lending services to these small businesses.

- Overlay Opportunity Zones with the HUBZones identified by SBA and identify areas of intersection
- Understand USDA priority for rural areas within the intersection
- Create template for multiple levels of services
 - Contracting benefits accruing from being in a HUBZone
 - Capital gain deferral and elimination benefits by investing in companies located at the intersection – due to Opportunity Zone benefit
 - Potential lending programs for companies located at the intersection
- Create awareness of the multiple services across the field teams

Increase awareness and educate rural small businesses on SBA certification programs such as 8a and HUBZone so that these businesses can participate in federal contracting programs.

- Schedule and provide training programs on certifications including 8a and HUBZone to USDA field staff so that rural small businesses can take advantage of small business contracting set-asides with DOD and other Agencies
- Provide collateral on certifications that USDA can distribute through its field offices
- Reach out to DOD and other Agencies through our PCRs and OSDDBU's to promote HUBZone consideration for rural areas – research legality of “mandatory HUBZone consideration”

Entrepreneurial Development

Establish Innovation Clusters in rural areas so that rural small businesses can benefit from training and counseling in specific domain areas.

- Based on USDA feedback, included USDA rural programs in Clusters' solicitation to increase solicitation score for entities involved in these programs
- SBA/USDA coordinating to Increase Clusters' Solicitation awareness by preparing materials to distribute, and hosting a webinar to clarify the solicitation proposal process
- Regional Innovative Clusters Solicitation became live on Friday, 7/20/18. Deadline for solicitation proposals is August 24th, 2018
- Once the solicitation process is completed and the new Clusters are selected – SBA will collaborate with USDA in announcing the new Clusters focused on rural entrepreneurship

Improve outreach to Native American communities to help small businesses in these communities to start, grow and thrive.

- Native American Empowerment Training for August has been announced for North Dakota, Nevada, and Arizona; Details of trainings have been shared with USDA for distribution to raise awareness and attendance
- SBA's Office of Native American Affairs coordinated with USDA to increase participation in Tribal Consultations in New Mexico and Oklahoma - Tribal Consultations allow the public to discuss proposed changes to the 8(a) and other federal contracting programs
- SBA will continue to work to finalize upcoming Native American Empowerment program workshops locations and times for September; SBA will share finalized workshop information with USDA
