Dear Mr. Evers:

This letter is in final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated September 10, 2019. Your request sought:

1. The resume provided by Robert Cameron to CFPB in connection with determining his appropriate salary, or, if that is not available, a recent resume contained within the agency's records. We have no objection to the redaction of contact information (addresses, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses) for Mr. Cameron or references, or to the redaction of past salary information. Employment, education, and professional association information is not exempt and we object to any redactions of such information.
2. Any conflicts or ethics waivers or authorizations for Mr. Cameron, including authorizations pursuant to 5 C.F.R. § 2635.502.
3. Records reflecting any recusal determination made or issued for Mr. Cameron.
4. Any ethics agreement or ethics or recusal screening agreement or protocol for Mr. Cameron.
5. All calendars or calendar entries for Robert Cameron, including any calendars maintained on his behalf (e.g., by an administrative assistant).

(Date Range for Record Search: From 7/1/2019 To 9/11/2019).

Regarding item 1 of your request, a search of our Office of Human Capital for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 5 pages. Of those pages, I have determined that 0

pages of the records are granted in full, 5 pages are granted in part, and 0 pages are withheld in full pursuant to Title 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6).

Regarding items 2, 3 and 4 of your request, we conducted a reasonable search within the Legal Department for records that would be responsive to your request. Unfortunately, we were unable to identify or locate any responsive records at this time. None of the requested information exists within the date range of this request.

Regarding item 5 of your request, a search of our Private Education Loan Ombudsman's Office for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 71 pages that are granted in full. No deletions or exemptions have been claimed on these records.

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. The types of documents and/or information that we have withheld may consist home addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, or various other documents and/or information belonging to a third party that are considered personal. The privacy interests of the individuals in the records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.

You may appeal any of the responses or decisions set forth above. If you choose to file an appeal, you must do so within 90 calendar days from the date of this letter. Your appeal must be in writing, signed by you or your representative, and should contain the rationale for the appeal.
