Dear Mr. Evers:

This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) dated and received in this office on September 23, 2019 and assigned tracking number 19-471. Your request seeks emails, calendar entries, and attachments thereto involving former OMB Advisor Michael Williams and certain external individuals from January 20, 2017 through April 12, 2019.

We apologize for the delay in responding to your FOIA request. OMB is experiencing a significant backlog of FOIA requests and we are doing our best to respond to each request as expeditiously as possible with the resources available to us. In response to your FOIA request, OMB conducted a search of its files for documents and located four documents, consisting of six pages. Enclosed are all six pages, which we are releasing in part, with redactions made pursuant to FOIA exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). Exemption 6 protects personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
