Dear Mr. Evers:

Pursuant to your request for *all calendars or calendar entries for Senator Joan Huffman, including any calendars maintained on behalf of Senator Huffman* and receipt of your check for \$195.95 for the cost of producing the requested documents, I have enclosed the responsive documents.

The documents being released include information that has no connection with the transaction of official business and therefore is not subject to disclosure under the Public Information Act, such as certain personal and nongovernmental business information. In such cases those parts of the documents that contain information not subject to disclosure have been redacted.

Additionally, Sections 306.003 and 306.004, Government Code, provide that records of a member of the legislature or of the lieutenant governor that are composed exclusively of communications or memoranda of communications (which has been ruled to include calendars, schedules, telephone logs, etc.) with residents of this state and of personal information concerning the person communicating with the member or lieutenant governor are confidential by law, and public disclosure is prohibited to ensure the right of citizens of the state to petition state government without fear of harassment, retaliation, or public ridicule. Therefore, any information as described in Sections 306.003 and 306.004 has been redacted.

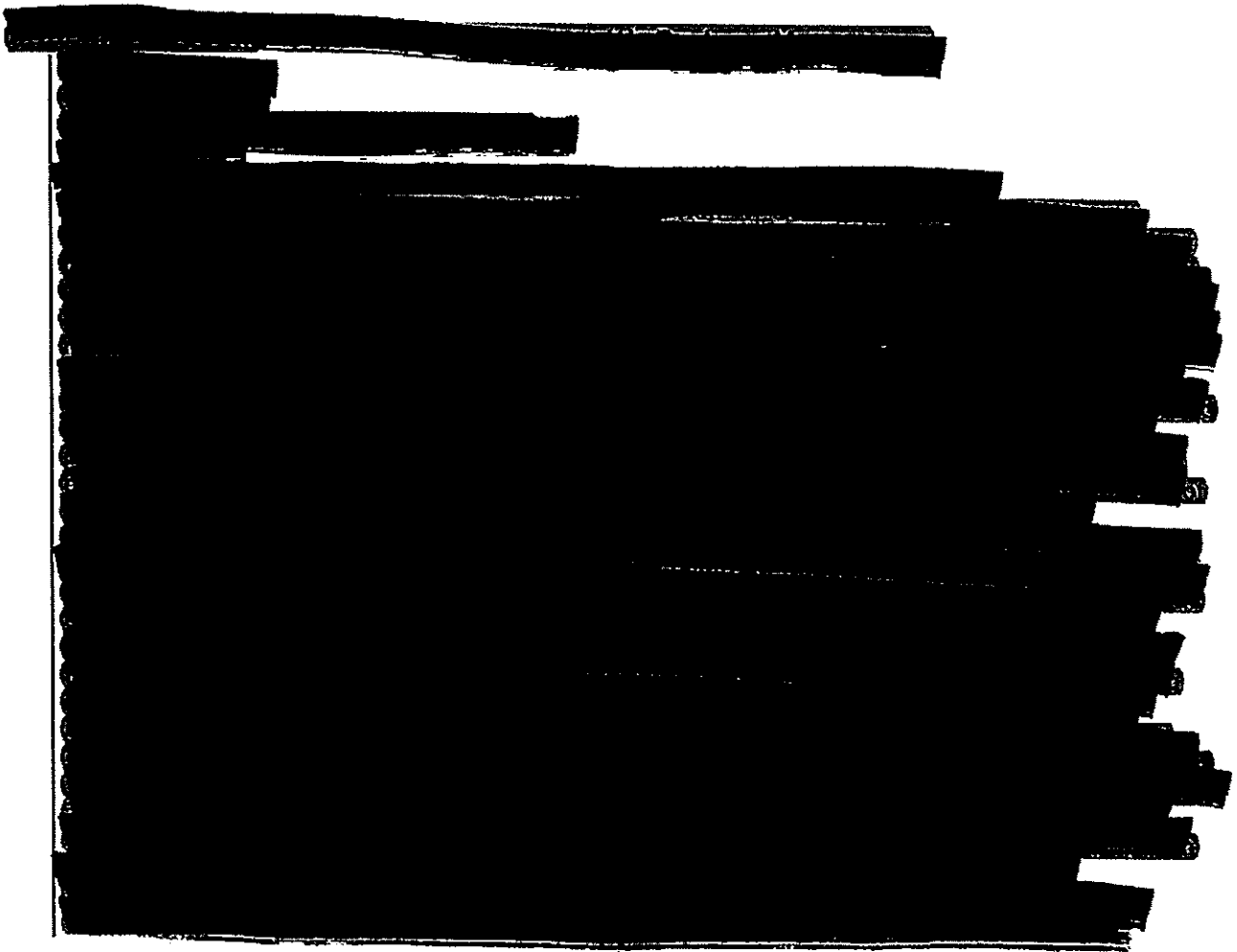

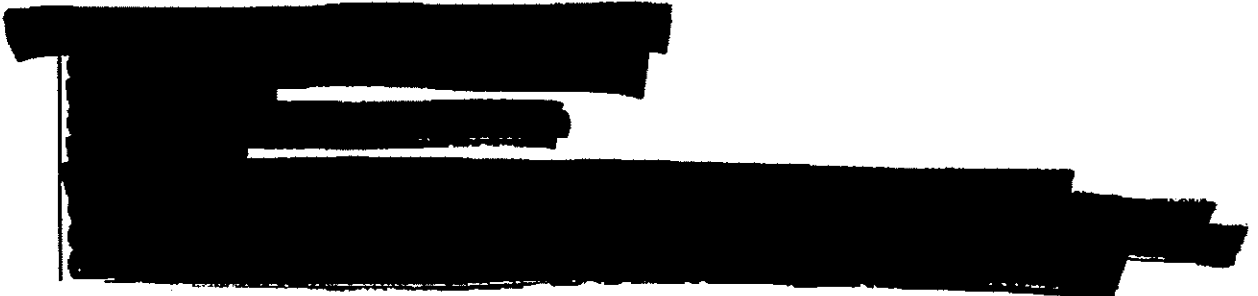
