To facilitate processing of the appeal, please include your mailing address and daytime telephone number, as well as a copy of the initial request and copy of this letter. Clearly mark "Freedom of Information Act Appeal" on the envelope and letter of the appeal. You must make any amendment to the appeal in writing and we must receive it prior to a decision. Address the appeal to the Solicitor of Labor, Division of Management and Administrative Legal Services, U.S. Department of Labor, 200 Constitution
