Dear Ms. Kannan:

Pursuant to your public records request submitted on October 21, 2019, the Senate has found no responsive records for the following request:

Timeframe: November 8, 2016 – October 21, 2019

“American Oversight requests that the Florida Senate promptly produce the following:

1. **All e-mail communications (including complete email chains, email attachments, calendar invitations, and calendar invitation attachments) sent by (a) any of the members of the Florida Senate and staff listed in Column A below to (b) any of the individuals or entities listed in Column B below.**

In an effort to accommodate the Senate and reduce the number of responsive records to be processed and produced, American Oversight has limited the email portion of its request to emails sent by the individuals in the Senate and anyone acting as their chief of staff, scheduler or assistant. To be clear, however, American Oversight still requests that complete email chains be produced, displaying both the sent messages and the prior received messages in each email chain. This means, for example, that both the individual’s response to an email from a listed entity and the initial received message are responsive to this request and should be produced.

2. **All non-email communications (including letters, memoranda, text messages, or other communications) between (a) any of the members of the Florida Senate and staff listed in Column A below and (b) any of the individuals or entities listed in Column B below.**
