This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), Title 5, United States Code, Section 552, request dated November 8, 2019, to the U.S. Census Bureau's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Office. We received your request in this office on November 8, 2019. We have assigned to it tracking number DOC-CEN-2020-000219 and are responding under the FOIA to your request for:

For the period January 20, 2017 through present, all email communications (including e-mails, e-mail attachments, calendar invitations, and attachments thereto) between:

We located no records responsive to your request. The Census Bureau does not have access to Ms. Jones personal e-mail account.

All appeals should include a statement of the reasons why the records requested should be made available and why the adverse determination was in error. The appeal letter, the envelope, the e-mail subject line, should be clearly marked "**Freedom of Information Act Appeal.**"

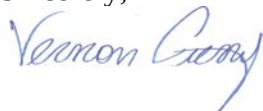

FOIA appeals posted to the e-mail box, fax machine, FOIAonline, or Office after normal business hours will be deemed received on the next normal business day. If the 90th calendar day for submitting an appeal falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal public holiday, an appeal received by 5:00 p.m., Eastern Time, the next business day will be deemed timely.
