Portions of the records are also protected by 5 USC § 552 (b)(6), which permits the withholding of personnel, medical and similar files when disclosure of such information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

To make it easier for congressional consideration, here's an even narrower version of the proposed bonding language.

Amend 214(a)(1):

(a) (1)(A) The admission to the United States of any alien as a nonimmigrant shall be for such time and under such conditions as the **Secretary of Homeland Security** ~~Attorney General~~ may by regulations prescribe, ~~which shall include~~ when he deems necessary the giving of a bond with sufficient surety in such sum and containing such conditions as the ~~Attorney General~~ shall prescribe, to insure that at the expiration of such time or upon failure to maintain the status under which he was admitted, or to maintain any status subsequently acquired under section 248, such alien will depart from the ~~United States~~. No alien admitted to Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands without a visa pursuant to section 212(l) may be authorized to enter or stay in the United States other than in Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands or to remain in Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands for a period exceeding 45 days from date of admission to Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands. No alien admitted to the United States without a visa pursuant to section 217 may be authorized to remain in the United States as a nonimmigrant visitor for a period exceeding 90 days from the date of admission.

(B) The Secretary of Homeland Security shall, every year, publish a Federal Register Notice describing the categories of applicants for admission who shall be required to give a bond with sufficient surety in such sum and containing such conditions as the Secretary shall prescribe in such Notice, to insure that at the expiration of the time for which the alien is admitted or upon failure to maintain the status under which he was admitted, or to maintain any status subsequently acquired under section 248, such alien will depart from the

United States. The Secretary may, in her discretion, amend the categories of applicants described in such Notice and any other terms of such Notice, as the Secretary in her discretion determines to be necessary to insure the timely departure from the United States of nonimmigrant aliens.

Thanks, Stephen. Coming in to this late, but I concur that any adjustments should be commensurate with a corresponding increase in resources for our colleagues at DHS, and additional resources at DOJ (i.e. immigration judges in EOIR, as well as investigatory resources at IER to ensure that the influx of workers does not result in illegal discrimination against American workers, AUSAs to bring cases, etc.). While I do understand the argument from some corners that H-2B workers are more likely to comply with the terms of their admission and not overstay, it is undeniable that some do. That said, it seems as though concerns on all levels could be somewhat mitigated by tweaking the program so that beneficiaries under the program would waive their right to an immigration court hearing if they violate the terms of their admission (similar to VWP).

Thank you for the call last night and the input from all of you over the past several months as we work to find an agreeable, narrow solution for inclusion in the omnibus. We know that no one – from our members, to industry, to the administration – is thrilled with this text, which sounds to me like we have mastered the art of compromise in this proposal.

We spent all last night and up until this point today running the traps on the proposals you sent us from both an industry and member perspective.

Attached, please find a document offering responses to the four proposals we

have reviewed. With the exception of the disaster relief exemption, we hope to further explore each proposal in the context of broader H-2B reform.
