This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of November 12, 2019 in which you requested the following information in possession, custody or control of DOL:

Our thorough records search of Department of Labor, (DOL), Bureau of International Labor Affairs, (ILAB) agency records yielded nothing responsive pertaining to your request.

Although no records were located during our search, you have the right to appeal a "no records" response. You may administratively appeal by writing to the Solicitor of Labor within 90 days from the date of this letter if you are not satisfied with the response to this request. The appeal must state in writing the grounds for the appeal, and it may include any supporting statements or arguments, but such statements are not required. In order to facilitate processing of the appeal, please include your mailing address and daytime telephone number as well as a copy of the initial request and a copy of this letter. The envelope and letter of the appeal should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." Any amendment to the appeal must be made in writing and received prior to a decision.

The appeal should be addressed to the Solicitor of Labor, Division Management Administrative Legal Services U.S. Department of Labor, 200 Constitution Avenue, Room N2420, Washington D.C., 20210. Appeals may also be submitted by email to foiaappeal@dol.gov. Appeals submitted to any other email address will not be accepted.
