This letter is the third interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552) request of 11/08/2019, which you sent to Hugh Gilmore, Director, Division of Freedom of Information Act, Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS). CMS assigned your FOIA request the case number 111220197045. In this request, you sought the following records for the time period January 1, 2018 to the present:

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By agreement of the parties in October 2020, in an effort to streamline the processing of potentially responsive documents, CMS would prioritize parent emails and would only process attachments of responsive parent emails.

In this third interim response, we processed a total of one thousand three hundred and sixteen (1,316) pages of records and determined that four (4) pages were responsive to your FOIA request. I am withholding four (4) pages in full.

The withholdings in full are pursuant to Exemption (b)(5) (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5)) and Exemption (b)(6) (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6)). The specific exemption claimed is notated on each page as withheld in full.

We are continuing our review of records potentially responsive to your requests. As additional reviews and disclosure determinations are completed, CMS will release any nonexempt records to you on a rolling basis as agreed by the parties.
