Dear Rep. La Rosa,

Occupational licensing is intended to protect the public from unsafe and low-quality service, but a broad and growing consensus among economists suggests that licensure is not the most effective way to ensure quality. Licensing rules protect incumbent providers from competition, raise consumer prices without improving quality, and [limit opportunities](#) for new entrants in the field.

Mercatus Senior Research Fellow Matt Mitchell is our expert on the subject of occupational licensing reform. If interested, I can organize a phone briefing between you and Matt to discuss the [effects of occupational licensure](#) on competition, consumers, and the workforce or [recommend reforms](#). Matt is available for testimony with adequate notice.

I look forward to hearing from you if you plan to work on this issue moving forward.
