This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), and fee waiver requests addressed to the U.S. Department of Labor's (DOL) Office of the Solicitor in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a). The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Policy (OASP) conducted an agency search for the records listed below from January 20, 2017, through February 20, 2018, regarding an Executive Order to expand the availability of short-term, limited-duration insurance:
