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Good news! Ron Labasky and Maria Matthews will be able to attend the meeting. The following is a proposed agenda to address laws, rules and practices that need to be revised to protect voter data in Florida.

Draft Agenda

LEGISLATIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE RULE REVISIONS TO PROTECT VOTER DATA :

- 1) Review proposed revisions to *FS 98.0981, Reports; voting history; statewide voter registration system information; precinct-level election results; book closing statistics.*

Fortunately, unless you have other revisions, it appears this statute will not require many revisions. I have attached a draft (**ATTACHMENT 1**) with the sections to be amended. A few points that need to be made are:

- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)1.a-d: These revisions simply combine provisional ballots into the group (election day or early voting) where they were voted and removes the granular reporting of provisional ballots;
- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)4: By removing "Vote Date" it removes the risk of ballots that are cast after Election Day (provisional ballots and overseas voters). In the voter history report it should simply reflect Election Day and not provide the exact date and time a voter's ballot was cast or counted. Again, this removes the granular detail that could jeopardize the secrecy of a voter's ballot.
- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)4: This section is further revised to exclude voters who have requested their information be exempt from public records. If they were included, the precinct and district information could reveal the address, or general proximity to the address, where they reside.

Election Day and not provide the exact date and time a voter's ballot was cast or counted. Again, this removes the granular detail that could jeopardize the secrecy of a voter's ballot.

- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)4: This section is further revised to exclude voters who qualify for and have requested their information be exempt from public records. If they were included, the precinct and district information could reveal the address, or general proximity to the address, where they reside.
- o FS 98.0981(2)(a): I feel that the wording “unless ***fewer than 10*** voters voted a ballot type” is arbitrary and may jeopardize the secrecy of voters' ballots in certain circumstances, i.e. nine voters voted for the same candidate on the same ballot type. I revised the section to include additional language to, hopefully, eliminate the risk.

Rule 1S-2.053 *Election Results, Precinct-Level Election Results, Voting History, and Reconciliation Reporting* will need to be opened to address like provisions in the Rule.

- 2) Review proposed revisions to *FS 106.011(16)(a), Definitions*, and/or other sections in Chapter 106 pertaining to political committees, to clarify the definition of “Political committee.” I feel strongly that voter data is at risk as a result of the broadness and lack of specifics relating to definition of political committees, unless revised. It is my understanding that two or more newspapers are currently registered as political committees, meaning they can obtain certain exempt information that isn't available to the public. I am hopeful that Dave or Ron can assist in helping define this further. I have attached a shell document (**ATTACHMENT 2**) with one section that might need to be amended. Of course, there may be other areas of the Election Code that need revisions as it relates to this issue.
- 3) Review proposed revisions to *FS 101.62, Requests for vote-by-mail ballots*. Again, I am providing a shell (**ATTACHMENT 3**) for revisions to be proposed, if necessary. Two things here:
 - a. The statute provides “*For each request for a vote-by-mail ballot received, the supervisor shall record*”
 - *the date the request was made,*
 - *the date the vote-by-mail ballot was delivered to the voter or the voter's designee or the date the vote-by-mail ballot was delivered to the post office or other carrier,*
 - *the date the ballot was received by the supervisor,*
 - *the absence of the voter's signature on the voter's certificate, if applicable,*
 - *and such other information he or she may deem necessary.*
 - b. It further provides: “*This information shall be confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and shall be made available to or reproduced only for the voter requesting the ballot, a canvassing board, an election official, a political party or official thereof, a candidate who has filed qualification papers and is opposed in an upcoming election, and registered political committees.*” So, the bulleted information above is the only information that Florida law requires be provided to candidates, political parties, political committees, etc.

It is *Rule 1S-2.043 Electronic File Reporting Relating to Vote-by-Mail Ballot Request* that exceeds the statutory authority and needs to be revised. There was a hearing on November 14, 2017 to revise this Rule, and my Comments on Proposed Revisions to the Rule are attached (**ATTACHMENTS 4-7**). The data file should not include **the address where the ballot is to be mailed, emailed or faxed, etc.**, only what is required by law (bulleted items). I will be requesting that this Rule be re-opened or continued.

- 4) Review FS 97.0585 *Public records exemption; information regarding voters and voter registration; confidentiality*. See #3-4 on our 2019 FSASE Legislative Priorities (**ATTACHMENT 8**). What is the status of these two legislative priorities? Has a bill been drafted? Is there anything we can contribute?

I have tried to put this together to get the discussion and agenda items started. Please let me know if you feel anything should be changed, added, etc. I look forward to seeing you soon.

LEGISLATIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE RULE REVISIONS TO PROTECT VOTER DATA:

- 1) Review proposed revisions to *FS 98.0981, Reports; voting history; statewide voter registration system information; precinct-level election results; book closing statistics.*

Fortunately, unless you have other revisions, it appears this statute will not require many revisions. I have attached a draft (**ATTACHMENT 1**) with the sections to be amended. A few points that need to be made are:

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STATUS: It was the consensus to move forward with the proposed changes to FS 98.0981 as outlined above (see Attachment 1) . The draft may still need to be tweaked. Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-

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STATUS: It was the consensus that no action was needed as it relates to Item 2 since Rule 1S-2.043 exceeds statutory authority and can be revised to exclude information that is not required by law (see next item). Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.043 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks.

- 3) Review proposed revisions to FS 101.62, *Requests for vote-by-mail ballots*. Again, I am providing a shell (**ATTACHMENT 3**) for revisions to be proposed, if necessary. Two things here:
 - a. The statute provides “ *For each request for a vote-by-mail ballot received, the supervisor shall record*
 - *the date the request was made,*
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 - *and such other information he or she may deem necessary.*
 - b. It further provides: “ *This information shall be confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and shall be made available to or reproduced only for the voter requesting the ballot, a canvassing board, an election official, a political party or official thereof, a candidate who has filed qualification papers and is opposed in an upcoming election, and registered political committees.*” So, the bulleted information above is the only information that Florida law requires be provided to candidates, political parties, political committees, etc.

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STATUS: It was the consensus that the only action needed at this time is to revise Rule 1S-2.043. Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.043 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks.

- 4) Review FS 97.0585 *Public records exemption; information regarding voters and voter registration; confidentiality*. See #3-4 on our 2019 FSASE Legislative Priorities (**ATTACHMENT 8**). What is the status of these two legislative priorities? Has a bill been drafted? Is there anything we can contribute?

STATUS: It was the consensus to pursue the exemption of *email address* and *phone number* from voter registration applications and voter records. The *date of birth* should also be exempt and replaced with the voter's *age* for demographic purposes. These changes could be added to the bill exempting information on 16-17 year old pre-registrants, if it doesn't jeopardize the passage of same. Alan Hays, as Legislative Chair, will probably need to handle how to proceed with these revisions. Reasons given for exempting *email* and *phone number* are:

- Voters are more likely to provide their contact information if it is not a public record but is used for the purpose of contacting voters to cure registration, vote by mail, provisional ballots, addresses, etc. Only the SOE and staff should be able to use the information.
 - The information is used by candidates and political committees to text voters, which was very upsetting to voters in the 2018 elections.
 - Voters hesitate to provide their contact information as they do not want it used by others, only the SOE office.
 - The date of birth (along with the last name and street number of the voter's address) is used to access the MY VOTER INFO and various other online voter services. All of the data needed to access these online services are available to the public in a voter registration list. The date of birth needs to be exempted for this purpose and also to reduce identity theft.
 - This Legislature has exempted this information from the Tax Collector's records.
- 5) Review Rule 1S-2.032 *Uniform Design for Election Ballots*. Many groups are now requesting copies of voted ballots from the saved images on the voting equipment or the Independent Audit System. Need to add another instruction to the ballot to notify voters not to sign or put identifying information on their ballots to maintain the secrecy of their ballot. See markup of Rule and FWAB instructions. (**ATTACHMENT 9**).

STATUS: Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.032 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks.

If it is determined that the person was registered and entitled to vote at the precinct where the person cast a vote in the election, the canvassing board shall, if the supervisor has not already done so, compare the signature on the Provisional Ballot Voter’s Certificate and Affirmation with the signature on the voter’s registration and, if it matches, shall count the ballot. “
The added language is the same as is provided for the comparison of signatures for Vote by Mail ballots. Without the added language, it requires the canvassing board to compare the signatures on provisional ballots. (See Attachment 2.)

7) Revise Rule 1S-2.030 *Vote-by-Mail Ballots for Absent Stateside Uniformed Services and Overseas Voters*, to provide that Absent Stateside voters can return their vote by mail ballots by fax as is currently allowed for overseas voters. Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.032 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks.

PRACTICES OF DIVISION AND/OR SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS:

- Do not release precinct-level results until after the election has been certified.
- Before releasing precinct-level results, review to make sure there are no contests with the same votes cast in a precinct or split.
- Do not provide Get Out The Vote (GOTV) data on Election Day.
- Review database reports created by voter registration vendors to ensure all reports follow the same practices, i.e. Codes F and Z are not on Voter History Reports; Precincts/Districts are not shown in reports for Address Protected Voters; etc.

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It is *Rule 1S-2.043 Electronic File Reporting Relating to Vote-by-Mail Ballot Request* that exceeds the statutory authority and needs to be revised. There was a hearing on November 14, 2017 to revise this Rule, and my Comments on Proposed Revisions to the Rule are attached. **FILED ON 11-15-2017 IN 00188**. The data file should not include **the address where the ballot is to be mailed, emailed or faxed, etc.**, only what is required by law (bulleted items). I will be requesting that this Rule be re-opened or

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STATUS: It was the consensus that the only action needed at this time is to revise Rule 1S-2.043. Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.043 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks.

- 4) Review FS 97.0585 *Public records exemption; information regarding voters and voter registration; confidentiality*. See #3-4 on our 2019 FSASE Legislative Priorities (**ATTACHMENT 8**). What is the status of these two legislative priorities? Has a bill been drafted? Is there anything we can contribute?

STATUS: It was the consensus to pursue the exemption of *email address* and *phone number* from voter registration applications and voter records. The *date of birth* should also be exempt and replaced with the voter's *age* for demographic purposes. These changes could be added to the bill exempting information on 16-17 year old pre-registrants, if it doesn't jeopardize the passage of same. Alan Hays, as Legislative Chair, will probably need to handle how to proceed with these revisions. Reasons given for exempting *email* and *phone number* are:

- Voters are more likely to provide their contact information if it is not a public record but is used for the purpose of contacting voters to cure registration, vote by mail, provisional ballots, addresses, etc. Only the SOE and staff should be able to use the information.
- The information is used by candidates and political committees to text voters, which was very upsetting to voters in the 2018 elections.
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- The date of birth (along with the last name and street number of the voter's address) is used to access the MY VOTER INFO and various other online voter services. All of the data needed to access these online services are available to the public in a voter registration list. The date of birth needs to be exempted for this purpose and also to reduce identity theft.
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The added language is the same as is provided for the comparison of signatures for Vote by Mail ballots. Without the added language, it requires the canvassing board to compare the signatures on provisional ballots. (See Attachment 2.)

7) Revise Rule 1S-2.030 *Vote-by-Mail Ballots for Absent Stateside Uniformed Services and Overseas Voters*, to provide that Absent Stateside voters can return their vote by mail ballots by fax as is currently allowed for overseas voters. Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.030 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks.

PRACTICES OF DIVISION AND/OR SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS:

- Do not release precinct-level results until after the election has been certified.
- Before releasing precinct-level results, review to make sure there are no contests with the same votes cast in a precinct or split.
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- Review database reports created by voter registration vendors to ensure all reports follow the same practices, i.e. Codes F and Z are not on Voter History Reports; Precincts/Districts are not shown in reports for Address Protected Voters; etc.

I feel strongly that voter data is at risk as a result of the broadness and lack of specifics relating to definition of political committees, unless revised. It is my understanding that two or more newspapers are currently registered as political committees, meaning they

can obtain certain exempt information that isn't available to the public. I am hopeful that you will be able to assist in helping define this further. I have attached a shell document (**ATTACHMENT 2**) with one section that might need to be amended. Of course, there may be other areas of the Election Code that need revisions as it relates to

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- *the date the request was made,*
 - *the date the vote-by-mail ballot was delivered to the voter or the voter's designee or the date the vote-by-mail ballot was delivered to the post office or other carrier,*
 - *the date the ballot was received by the supervisor,*
 - *the absence of the voter's signature on the voter's certificate, if applicable,*
 - *and such other information he or she may deem necessary.*

Again, this removes the granular detail that could jeopardize the secrecy of a voter's ballot.
- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)4: This section is further revised to exclude voters who qualify for and have requested their information be exempt from public records. If they were included, the precinct and district information could reveal the address, or general proximity to the address, where they reside.
- o FS 98.0981(2)(a): I feel that the wording "unless ***fewer than 10*** voters voted a ballot type" is arbitrary and may jeopardize the secrecy of voters' ballots in certain circumstances, i.e. nine voters voted for the same candidate on the same ballot type. LEGISLATIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE RULE REVISIONS TO PROTECT VOTER DATA:

Fortunately, unless you have other revisions, it appears this statute will be required by 2021. I have attached a draft (**ATTACHMENT 1**) with the sections to be amended. A few points that need to be made are:

Fortunately, unless you have other revisions, it appears this statute will not require many revisions. I have attached a draft (**ATTACHMENT 1**) with the sections to be amended. A few points that need to be made are:

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STATUS: It was the consensus to move forward with the proposed changes to FS 98.0981 as outlined above (see Attachment 1) . The draft may still need to be tweaked. Maria Matthews will open Rule 1S-2.053 for workshop and comment in the coming weeks. - o FS 98.0981(1)(d)1.a-d: These revisions simply combine provisional ballots into the group (election day or early voting) where they were voted and removes the granular reporting of provisional ballots;
- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)4: By removing "Vote Date" it removes the risk of ballots that are cast after Election Day (provisional ballots and overseas voters). In the voter history report it should simply reflect Election Day and not provide the exact date and time a voter's ballot was cast or counted. Again, this removes the granular detail that could jeopardize the secrecy of a voter's ballot.
- o FS 98.0981(1)(d)4: This section is further revised to exclude voters who qualify for and have requested their information be exempt from public records. If they were included, the precinct and district information could reveal the address, or general proximity to the address, where they reside.
- o FS 98.0981(2)(a): I feel that the wording "unless **fewer than 10** voters voted a ballot type" is arbitrary and may jeopardize the secrecy of voters' ballots in certain circumstances, i.e.

nine voters voted for the same candidate on the same ballot type. I revised the section to include additional language to, hopefully, eliminate the risk.

- o FS 98.0981(2)(a): I feel that the wording “unless ***fewer than 10*** voters voted a ballot type” is arbitrary and may jeopardize the secrecy of voters’ ballots in certain circumstances, i.e.

nine voters voted for the same candidate on the same ballot type. I revised the section to include additional language to, hopefully, eliminate the risk.

Rule 1S-2.053 *Election Results, Precinct-Level Election Results, Voting History, and Reconciliation Reporting* will need to be opened to address like provisions in the Rule.

- 2) Review proposed revisions to *FS 106.011(16)(a), Definitions*, and/or other sections in Chapter 106 pertaining to political committees, to clarify the definition of “Political committee.” I feel strongly that voter data is at risk as a result of the broadness and lack of specifics relating to definition of political committees, unless revised. It is my understanding that two or more newspapers are currently registered as political committees, meaning they can obtain certain exempt information that isn’t available to the public. I am hopeful that Dave or Ron can assist in helping define this further. I have attached a shell document (**ATTACHMENT 2**) with one section that might need to be amended. Of course, there may be other areas of the Election Code that need revisions as it relates to this issue.
- 3) Review proposed revisions to *FS 101.62, Requests for vote-by-mail ballots*. Again, I am providing a shell (**ATTACHMENT 3**) for revisions to be proposed, if necessary . Two things here:
 - a. The statute provides “ *For each request for a vote-by-mail ballot received, the supervisor shall record*
 - *the date the request was made,*
 - *the date the vote-by-mail ballot was delivered to the voter or the voter’s designee or the date the vote-by-mail ballot was delivered to the post office or other carrier,*
 - *the date the ballot was received by the supervisor,*
 - *the absence of the voter’s signature on the voter’s certificate, if applicable,*
 - *and such other information he or she may deem necessary.*
 - b. It further provides: “ *This information shall be confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and shall be made available to or reproduced only for the voter requesting the ballot, a canvassing board, an election official, a political party or official thereof, a candidate who has filed qualification papers and is opposed in an upcoming election, and registered political committees.*” So, the bulleted information above is the only information that Florida law requires be provided to candidates, political parties, political committees, etc.

The statute may need to be revised to define “for political purposes only.”

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I have tried to put this together to get the discussion and agenda items started. Please let me know if you feel anything should be changed, added, etc. I look forward to seeing you soon.
