Dear Mr. Evers:

This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) dated and received in this office on January 8, 2020, and assigned tracking number 2020-149. Your request seeks all records from February 1, 2019 reflecting communications (including emails, email attachments, text messages, messages on messaging platforms), telephone call logs, calendar invitations, calendar entries, meeting notices, meeting agendas, informational material, draft legislation, talking points, any handwritten or electronic notes taken during any oral communications, summaries of any oral communications, or other materials) between a list of OMB officials and Rudolph Giuliani, or anyone communicating on his behalf (such as Jo Ann Zafonte, Christianne Allen, Beau Wagner, or anyone communicating from an email address ending in giulianisecurity.com, giulianipartners.com, or gdcillc.com).

In a subsequent email communication on July 28, 2022, Mr. Hart Wood from your office, narrowed the scope of the FOIA request to “only [Mick] Mulvaney’s and [Russ] Vought’s emails.” In response to your FOIA request, as revised on July 28, 2022, OMB initiated a search based on the parameters above and located no records responsive to your request.
