This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) request No. SBA-2020-000277 in which you have requested the following:

All records reflecting communications (including emails, email attachments, text messages, messages on messaging platforms (such as Slack, GChat or Google Hangouts, Lync, Skype, or WhatsApp), telephone call logs, calendar invitations, calendar entries, meeting notices, meeting agendas, informational material, talking points, any handwritten or electronic notes taken during any oral communications, summaries of any oral communications, or other materials) between (a) Linda McMahon, or anyone communicating on her behalf (for example, a scheduler, assistant, or chief of staff), and (b) any of the individuals or entities listed below, including but not limited to at the email addresses and domains specified:

- i. Rudolph “Rudy” Giuliani, including anyone communicating on his behalf such as Jo Ann Zafonte, Christianne Allen, or Beau Wagner;
- ii. Anyone communicating on behalf of Giuliani Partners, Giuliani Safety and Security, or Giuliani Deason Capital Interests (including but not limited to email addresses ending in gdcillc.com, giulianipartners.com, giulianisecurity.com);
- iii. Victoria Toensing (including but not limited to the email address vt@digenovatoensing.com);
- iv. Joseph diGenova (including but not limited to the email address jd@digenovatoensing.com);
- v. Lev Parnas (including but not limited to the email address lparnas@globalenergyproducers.com);

- vii. David Correia.
