




COVID-19 IN IDAHO

- The negative impact coronavirus is having on the health of Idahoans






Would you support or oppose the state making it mandatory to wear masks in public spaces to fight the coronavirus pandemic?




Would you support or oppose the state making it mandatory to wear masks in public spaces to fight the coronavirus pandemic, where not wearing a mask could be punishable by a fine?



If a vaccine to prevent COVID-19 were available today, would you get the vaccine?


